Ballet Term of the Month:

Rond de jambe [rawn duh zhahnb] – *Round of the leg.* A circular movement of the leg. There are several forms of rond de jambe. The first to be learned is **a terre [a tehr]** – *on the ground.* The working foot of a straight leg draws an arc on the floor moving from front to back (en dehors) or back to front (en dedans).
