










### General Shoot Rules



#### \*\*New CSTA Classifications Change\*\*

Shooters with less than 500 singles or doubles targets in the current target year will be advanced 1 class or more based on their ATA history and known ability. Shooters with less than 500 handicap targets in the current target year will be classified at a minimum of 25 yards or higher if their assigned ATA yardage is longer than 25 yards.

Penalty classification shall be waived for Senior Veteran and Lady II shooters.

#### **GENERAL SHOOT RULES**

- · Purses and options are not compulsory.
- Shooting starts promptly at the time indicated and only the starting squads will be called. Please watch the "ON DECK" signs.
- Shooters with less than 500 singles or doubles targets in the current target year will be advanced 1
  class or more based on their ATA history and known ability. Shooters with less than 500 HC targets in
  the current target year will be advanced at a minimum of 1/2-1 yard to the next yardage assignment.
  Penalty yardage not to exceed 25 yards. Class and yardage penalty advancement shall be waived for
  Senior Veteran and Lady II shooters.
- Squad Changes: There is a \$10.00 change fee for any squad changes made after 3:00 pm the
  previous day.
- Please attend the meeting for all Colorado Trap Shooters after the 1st 100 singles on Saturday, June 15th, 2024 to elect the ATA Delegate and Alternate Delegate. The Colorado State Team awards will also be presented, along with the Mike Herman Award
- Please attend the 2024 Hall of Fame ceremony and induction Friday, June 14th, after shooting is completed
- ALL EVENTS WILL BE SHOT 5 TARGETS PER POST, 50 PER TRAP (Shoot management reserves the right to modify this format.)
- · Ties for events A, C, 1 & 3 (Singles & Doubles) will be carried over to the next like event.
- Handicap ties will be determined by CSTA officials at the end of each day of shooting. If you do not report for shootoffs within the allotted time, you will forfeit. No exceptions to this rule. NO CARRY OVERS!
- The CSTA reserves the right to alter or modify the program and to reject anyone who, in our
  opinion is detrimental to the shoot.
- It is the responsibility of money winners to report their winning to the IRS.
   1099 Tax Forms for winnings over \$600.00
- Board of Directors meeting: Friday Night, June 14th, 2024 (time and place to be determined by the Board of Directors)
- Practice Traps will be open & available @ 7:30am daily. Practice rounds will be \$6.00 per 25 targets. Traps available will be posted near bank assignments along with announced. NOTE: During all CHAMPIONSHIP events practice fields will be limited to UPPER Fields up until first flight of shooters due to all 12 fields will be used during these events. DTC Trap Committee will modify/designate practice fields for the betterment of the shoot at their discretion.
- · Added money is open to all shooters entered in the event.
- Entrants for husband/wife (Domestic Partners) or two in a family (immediate family such as parent or siblings) in Event 5 must declare prior to the start of the event. You can win only one category.
- (1) It is the responsibility of all special category shooters to ensure they are placed in the correct category at the time they are classified/handicapped. If your special category does not appear on the bulletin sheet, report the omission at the cashier's.
- (2) Class Advance: High Score in each class in Events 1 & 3 will be advanced for all like events. Class advancements will apply independently to in-state and out-of-state classes. PAID OPTIONS FOLLOW SHOOTER TO ADVANCED CLASS.
- (3) 100 or 200 Straight Pins: Shooters breaking 100 or 200 straight without carryover will be awarded a 100 or 200 straight pin. Only one such pin will be awarded to any one individual.
- (4) There will be no co-winners/champions. Ties must be settled for trophies purposes and All American Points
- (5) Credit cards accepted with a 3% charge for all targets, options and purses

The annual meeting of the CSTA will be held in between singles June 15th, 2024

#### **Events of the Meeting:**

- Nominations for ATA Delegate & ATA Alternate Delegate
- \*\*Election of ATA Delegate & ATA Alternate Delegate

\*\*The criteria for election as a State Delegate or Alternate Delegate shall be actual physical residence within the boundaries of the State of Colorado, in receipt of life membership certificate from the A. T. A. and member in good standing of the Colorado State Trapshooting Association. A candidate for election must evidence membership in good standing for at least 5 consecutive years, active participation of at least 500 targets (Singles, Handicap and Doubles combined) in current and previous 4 years with at least 3,000 targets total in current and previous year. Target participation may be waived for shooters with an extensive target history who, because of documented physical problems, are not currently able to participate. A candidate must have not been suspended for any reason from the ATA.

Only those in possession of a current paid average card issued by the ATA can vote. (if you plan on voting for your ATA Delegate and ATA Alternate Delegate, please renew your ATA Membership prior to the state shoot). CSTA members who qualify will be given a ballot at registration.

## Special Categories





#### SPECIAL CATEGORY SHOOTERS

All Lady I, Lady II, Sub-Juniors, Junior, Junior Gold, Sub Veteran, Veterans, and Senior-Vets must declare their special category at the time of classification in any registered tournament if they wish to compete as a category shooter. Without such declaration, the contestant will not be allowed to compete for the applicable category trophy. No contestant will be allowed to declare or change a special declaration after firing his/her first shot. The only exception to this rule will be to correct an ATA classification error. The following rules apply to shooters who have declared a special category. At all tournaments where All American points will be awarded in any event, shooters may declare only one (1) category (i.e. Lady I, Lady II, Sub-Junior, Junior, Junior Gold, Sub-Veteran, Veteran, or Senior Veteran) Note: Chair shooters are exempt from this rule.

- 1. A female shooter, who has not reached her 55th Birthday, may declare Lady I.
- 2. A female shooter, who had reached her 55th Birthday, may declare Lady II.
- 3. A shooter who has not reached his/her 15th Birthday, may declare Sub-Junior.
- 4. A shooter who is 15 but has not reached his/her 18th Birthday may declare as Junior.
- 5. A shooter who is 18 but has not reached his/her 23rd Birthday may declare as Junior Gold.
- 6. A shooter who is 55 but not reached his/her 65th Birthday may declare as a Sub-Veteran.
- 7. A shooter who is 65 but not reached his/her 70th Birthday may declare as a Veteran.
- 8. A shooter who is 70 years of age and older may declare as a Senior Veteran.
- 9. Age based categories are established on the Birthday of the shooter. For purposes of determining age category for HOA and HAA awards the category declared by the participant of the first day he/she shoots shall be used.
- 10. Shooters who become eligible for new age based categories during the target year may elect to continue to compete in the previous category for the remainder of that target year. (For example a shooter reaching age 70 may elect to continue to shoot as a Veteran for the remainder of the current target year.) However, once a shooter has elected to move to the new category that decision is irrevocable and he/she may not again declare eligibility for the previous category. Junior shooters reaching the age of 18 may continue to declare Junior category for the remainder of the current target year. Note: Age based special category shooters that are in contention for or desire to achieve All-American Team recognition should review the All-American Team policy in the ATA Rule Book. When there is no Sub-Junior trophy Sub-Juniors will be included in the Junior category. Senior Veterans will be included in the Veteran category when there is no Senior Veteran trophy.

**PETS:** Shooters are required to have their pets leashed at all times while on the grounds. It is also mandatory that you clean up after your pet. Owners will be held liable/responsible for their animals.

**ATVs AND GOLF CARTS:** Use of personal ATVs and golf carts is allowed. Owner must have liability insurance.

The Handicap Committee reserves the right to reclassify any shooter at any time during the shoot

The A.T.A. rules will govern all points that are not otherwise provided. If you win your class or any event or earn yardage in any handicap, it is your responsibility to report such change to the Committee.

Appropriate hearing and eye protection will be worn by all personnel on the firing line; this includes employees who perform duties on or near the trap field.



## Rick Olson 2024 Award Recipient



Rick Olson began registering ATA targets in 1971. Accumulating 50,150 singles, 45650 handicap and 35100 doubles as of 2023 target year. Has earned AA-27-AA and was an AAA singles shooter. ATA life member 1999 & CSTA life member 2002 He has shot several 199's in singles, 99 in hdcp and doubles, 50 100 straights. Member 5 state teams as Veteran and Senior Veteran. Rick has won several state championships, major wins in singles and doubles state zone shoots. Has shot at 14 clubs across Colorado.

Proudest win 2017 CSTA Veterans State singles championship. Tied for Class A doubles at the Spring Grand in 1997 Has attended the majority of state shoots since 1971. He has shot in Wyoming, Nevada and Arizona. A member of the Eagle Valley Trap Club he helped build it while serving as Vice President, President and secretary during the '80's and '90's. Served as CSTA club delegate 1994-2001. Served as Western Zone Vice President from 1998 to 2001, CSTA president from 1998 to 2001, 2002 to 2003. He also served on CSTA Hall of Fame Committee 2010 to 2019, serving as President 2015-2019. As CSTA president he developed or help develop the following: AIM predecessor, Building Loan Program, update CSTA bylaws, Colorado Club location maps, early website development, raised funding for AIM, updated CSTA zone shoot guidelines, and helped create CSTA rookie if the year award. He credits many committee members for these accomplishments. As Hall of Fame president he revised the bylaws, tried to develop a youth shooter scholarship and a permanent home grounds for both CSTA and Hall of Fame. A native of Haxtun, CO his youth included hunting pheasants, doves, ducks & geese. Other interests include fishing, other hunting, farm mechanics and woodworking. He also has tied 110,000 fishing flies over 40 years. He received the Colorado State FFA farmer degree. He graduated from Northwestern Junior College and Colorado State University. Leadership roles began, & degrees in range ecology, math, and chemistry






