JUNE 18, 2017 – RESPECT AUTHORITY

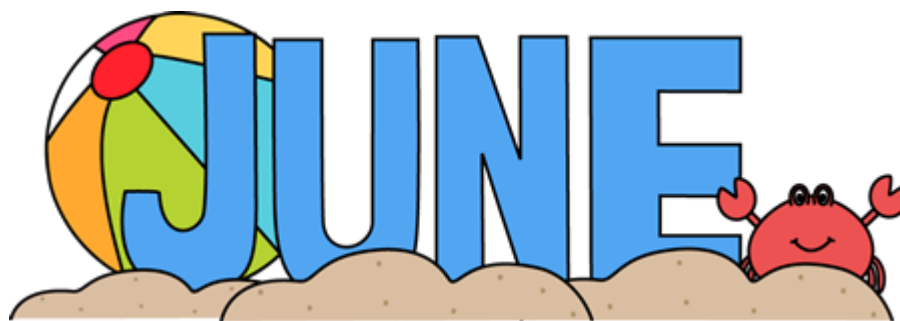
The Point: Respect the authorities God has placed in your life
