
- 5. The Bugs in the Garden (to the Wheels on the Bus) The (bees) in the garden go (buzz, buzz, buzz) .... All day long

marched around our music classroom with our music teacher, Mrs. Cooper,


singing "We are the dinosaurs" song and had so much fun pretending we were

## Caterpillars' Newsletter


#### Friendly Reminders:
