Lord's Acre 2019 Pie Baking Strawberry/Rhubarb... May 16th

Please pull and chop rhubarb ahead.
Freeze if early



Aug. 1, 8, 15, 21 & 22, 29

Making of the mincemeat will be Aug. 21

Please reserve these dates on your calendar for making Lord's Acre Pies this year. We encourage everyone to come and participate. We have need for those who are able to roll crusts, fill pie shells, bag and label the unbaked pies, clean, share in fellowship with others, test the finished products and to pray. You do not have to be an experienced pie maker, as we will teach you. Children are welcome to come play in the fellowship hall but we do not have babysitters. Older youth with their parents/grandparents permission are welcome in the kitchen. We need their help preparing the pie tins, dividing and distributing the dough, shuffling the pies to and from various locations, assisting the baker, bagging the unbaked pies, applying labels, cleaning and so much more as the needs arise.... if they are interested, we will find a mentor to teach them to roll the crusts.



If the rhubarb is early this year, please pull, clean, cut into 1/2" pieces and freeze when it is ready. If possible freeze on a cookie sheet and then bag so the pieces are separated and easy to measure and use frozen. We will have room in the church freezer to store the prepared rhubarb until we bake the pies on May 16th. Please contact Marlene Pedersen 541-410-8763 if you have rhubarb. We may also need a few helpers that can help gather and clean rhubarb for those that are unable to harvest their rhubarb. Please let Marlene know if you can help with this.

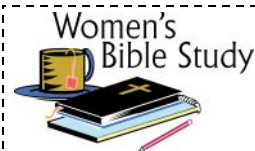


Women's Tea 2019

We meet every Wednesday at 9am for a devotion and prayer time, then break into the two study groups, concluding around 11am. All women are welcome!

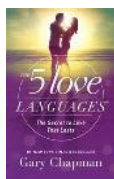


MARRIAGE CLASSES
