A Note from Rick: Mixed markets at TLA this week. Tuesday's markets were steady for dairy cattle and feeders, while the calf market and the slaughter market were lower. The calf market continues its struggle and after the past couple of weeks being slightly better, this week was not good at all. The slaughter market was down across the board. Butcher cows were \$3-\$5 lower and both colored and Holstein steers were \$4-\$6 cheaper. Thursday's spinger sale was a different story. The market was strong from top to bottom and was tested with a nice run of heifers. There continues to be more interest and activity in the dairy market and with the recent gains in milk futures on the board of trade I look for this to continue. Silage harvest is in full swing and all the reports I've heard have been pretty positive. Not quite the crop we had last year but definitely better than we thought it might be back in June when it wouldn't quit raining.
