There IS power in the Word of God ...

In Matthew 4:4, "Jesus answered, This writtens Man shall not live on bread alone, but on every word that comes from the month of God," Now in Hebrews 4:12 we see also, "For the word of God is alive and active. Sharper than any double-edged sword, it penetrates even to dividing soul and spirit, joints and marrow; it judges the thoughts and attitudes of the heart." Then in 1 Peter 1:23, "For you have been born again, not of perishable seed, but of imperishable, through the living and enduring word of God." Then the Apostle Paul encourages us with, in Romans 1:16, "For I am not ashamed of the gospel, because it is the power of God that brings salvation to everyone who believes: first to the Jew, then to the Gentile." Now let me encourage you to look up and read Isaiah 55:11 and Psalms 19:7-14.

There IS power in the name of Jesus ...

Let's read Acts 3:16 together, "By faith in the name of Jesus, this man whom you see and know was made strong. It is Jesus' name and the faith that comes through Him that has completely healed him, as you can all see." Proverbs 18:10 reads, "The name of the Lord is a fortified tower; the righteous run to it and are safe." And then, in Psalms 44:5, "Through You we push back our enemies; through Your name we trample our foes."

There IS power in the Blood of Jesus ...

Let's read Hebrews 5:8-9, "Son though He was, He learned obedience from what He suffered and, once made perfect, He became the source of eternal salvation for all who obey Him." Now, Hebrews 9:14, "How much more, then, will the blood of Christ, who through the eternal Spirit offered Himself unblemished to God, cleanse our consciences from acts that lead to death, so that we may serve the living God!" Look here in Hebrews 10:19-22, "Therefore, brothers and sisters, since we have confidence to enter the Most Holy Place by the blood of Jesus, by a new and living way opened for us through the curtain, that is, His body, and since we have a great Priest over the house of God, let us draw near to God with a sincere heart and with the full assurance that faith brings, having our hearts sprinkled to cleanse us from a guilty conscience and having our bodies washed with pure water." In Ephesians 1:7-9 Paul tells us, "In Him we have redemption through His blood, the forgiveness of sins, in accordance with the riches of God's grace that He lavished on us. With all wisdom and understanding, He made known to us the mystery of His will according to His good pleasure, which He purposed in Christ," Again here in Ephesians 2:13, the Apostle Paul, "But now in Christ Jesus you who once were far away have been brought near by the blood of Christ." And now, Revelation 12:11, "And they have defeated him (satan) by the blood of the Lamb and by their testimony, And they did not love their lives so much that they were afraid to die."

There IS power in the Holy Spirit ...

Acts 1:8 reads. "Suff you will receive power when the Holy Spirit comes on you; and you will be kly witnesses in

Jerusalam, and in all Judea and Samaria, and to the ends of the earth." And then, in 1 Corinthians 2:4-5, "My message and my preaching were not with wise and persuasive words, but with a demonstration of the Spirit's power, so that your faith might not rest on human wisdom, but on God's power."

There IS power in the Cross ...

In 1 Corinthians 1:18 Paul again, "For the message of the cross is foolishness to those who are perishing, but to us who are being saved it is the power of God." Again, in Colossians 1:19-20, Paul states, "For God was pleased to have all His fullness dwell in Him, and through Him to reconcile to Himself all things, whether things on earth or things in heaven, by making peace through His blood, shed on the cross."

There IS power in Praise ...

Psalms 22:3 reads, "Yet You are enthroned as the Holy One; You are the one Israel praises." 2 Timothy 1:7 assures us, "For the Spirit God gave us does not make us timid, but gives us power, love and self-discipline." Jesus has told us, in Luke 10:19, "I have given you withoutly to trample on status and sompless and to everyone all the power of the enemy nothing will have you." God has given us all the power to walk in victory in every area of our life. My question to us all is, "Are we living in that power so the world can see that we operate in the power to love, to forgive, to have true joy and to have divine health in our bodies?"

Proverbs 4:20-23 Solomon writes to his son David, and God through His Scriptures is telling us, "My son, pay attention to what I say; turn your ear to my words. Do not let them out of your sight, keep them within your heart; for they are life to those who find them and health to one's whole body. Above all else, guard your heart, for everything you do flows from it." And then in Psalms 103:1-5 we see that David took what his father had told him to heart as he says here, "Praise the Lord, my soul; all my inmost being, praise His holy name. Praise the Lord, my soul, and forget not all His benefits - who forgives all your sins and heals all your diseases, who redeems your life from the pit and crowns you with love and compassion, who satisfies your desires with good things so that your youth is renewed like the eagles."

The world is not looking for more problems, they are looking to us because we should realize that they have them. The world needs to see the power of God in our lives. If you didn't know it, I'm telling you, "All the power to live a victorious life is available to you RIGHT NOW!" We receive the power by spending time with God, who IS the source of that power. We also receive His power by spending time with Him in prayer, talking with God AND listening to Him, for He IS ALL power. One of the greatest places to begin to see and feel His power is by spending time with Him in His Word. Again, in Hebrews 4:10, we are encouraged, "For the Word of God is alive and active. Sharper than any double-edged sword, it penetrates even to dividing soul and spirit, joints and marrow; it judges the thoughts and attitudes of the heart."

This is very beneficial to us all, "And pray in the Spirit on all occasions with all kinds of prayers and requests. With this in mind, be alert and always keep on praying for all the Lord's people." (Ephesians 6:18) After all of the Armor listed in Ephesians 6:10-17, we're encouraged, in verse 18, to use the power that praying in tongues provides. In Jude 20-21 we find, "But you, dear friends, by building yourselves up in your most holy faith and praying in the Holy Spirit, keep yourselves in God's love as you wait for the mercy of our Lord Jesus Christ to bring you to eternal life."

Let me share with you all a few Scriptures about praying in the Spirit, praying in tongues which IS our heavenly prayer language. First in Acts 2:2-4, "Suddenly a sound like the blowing of a violent wind came from heaven and filled the whole house where they were sitting. They saw what seemed to be tongues of fire that separated and came to rest on each of them. All of them were filled with the Holy Spirit and began to speak in other tongues as the Spirit enabled them."

Acts 11:15-16, "As I began to speak, the Holy Spirit came on them as He had come on us at the beginning. Then I remembered what the Lord had said: "Jalun bagazzad with water, but you will be bagazzad with the Holy Spirit.""

Acts 19:6, "When Paul placed his hands on them, the Holy Spirit came on them, and they spoke in tongues and prophesied."

Mark 16:17, "And these signs will accompany those who believe: In My name they will drive out demons; they will speak in new tengues ..."

1 Corinthians 14:1-2, "For anyone who speaks in a tongue does not speak to people but to God. Indeed, no one understands them; they utter mysteries by the Spirit."

I had a pretty rough 2020. Last March, my wife died from injuries she got in a massive house fire that her and her girlfriend were staying in while they were on vacation in Las Vegas. You could probably guess that I was devastated over it. I had to leave my children to take responsibility for all her medical decisions because she survived for five days after the fire and finally passed away. I couldn't imagine what she went through in those five days and I prayed and asked the Lord to take her if it was her time. My relationship with God is strong and I never questioned why. I know she is at His right hand and I am at peace with it now. As far as I go, I have worked on my post conviction relief for two years. This past February, my attorney received new evidence that clears my guilt. I sunk myself deep into my case and now we are waiting on a date for an evidentiary hearing. Once I get that hearing, I should get granted a new trial based on that evidence alone. God has kept me patient and at peace, while we've been fighting this. My attorney told me that if we get a new trial, there is no way the state will want to go against me and they will probably come at me with a "time served" plea, which I would sign. My Experience About Matthew 6:1 By M.D.

Matthew 6:1, "Be [very] careful not to do your good deeds publisly, to be seen by men; otherwise you will have no reward [prepared and awaiting you] with your Father who is in heaven."



Here Jesus warns us about trying to impress people with our good deeds and instead encourages us to wait for our reward from God. God really brought this point home in me once through something that happened in my life. I was getting my hair cut in my uncle's old school barber shop in the downtown main street of Yuma, Arizona. I happened to be wearing a diamond 'Jesus' tie pin that I had stuck in my hat. God prompted me to give it to a male nurse who was also in the shop sitting in the chair next to me talking about ministering to cancer patients in the Yuma Regional Medical Center where he worked. He said he was not allowed to preach to them openly, but wanted to be able to minister to them somehow.

I felt the Lord leading me to give him my Jesus pin so that when he wore it, as he bent over his patients, the name of Jesus would minister to them. I hesitated because I knew the Lord wanted me to do it privately, but saw no way to so because the barbers doing our haircuts, as well as the room full of men waiting their turn. Suddenly my uncle asked the barber next to me to help him go get something out of the back. I knew God was making a way for me to give the nurse my pin discreetly and without any fan fare. BUT, my flesh, (Matthew) wanted some credit. So instead of doing what God wanted me to do and the way that He wanted me to do it I kept putting it off, reasoning to myself, "I think it would bless these other men to see my generosity."

So, I waited until my uncle and the other barber got back and made a big deal about giving it to the nurse. Just as I had thought, everyone expounded on my generosity, going on and on about how kind of me it was to give this man my diamond Jesus pin. As I left my uncle's shop thinking about how generous I had been, the Holy Spirit spoke to my heart saying, "Well, I hope you enjoyed that because it is all the reward you're going to get. Whatever you would have had from Me, you just traded for those compliments." I wonder what God would have done for me had I obeyed what He had told me to do, letting Him have all the glory and credit? Let me urge you not to make the same mistake I did. Obey God and do what He wants you to do, when He wants you to do it, the way He wants you to do it!

Repentance in Faith By H.M.

In the 19th century a preacher by the name of Charles Spurgeon said, "Now, contentment is one of the flowers of heaven, and it must be cultivated." Mother Theresa said, "It's not what you do, but how much love you put into it that matters." So please believe me when I say, "Your love cultivates hope." This following quote from Helen Keller is exemplar of a true Christian walk, especially for those in prison. "Character cannot be developed in ease and quite, only through experience of trial and suffering can the soul be strengthened, vision cleared, ambition inspired and success achieved. Although the world is full of suffering, it is also full of overcoming it." All of us in prison know how easily sin can gain a foothold in our lives. Praise God that Christ accepts all who come to Him in repentance and faith, even sinners whom are whispered about and despised.

Now let's read Luke 7:36-50 and consider them together. "When one of the Pharisees invited Jesus to have dinner with him, He went to the Pharisee's house and reclined at the table. A woman in that town who lived a sinful life learned that Jesus was eating at the Pharisee's house, so she came there with an alabaster jar of perfume. As she stood behind Him at His feet weeping, she began to wet His feet with her tears. Then she wiped them with her hair, kissed them and poured perfume on them. When the Pharisee who had invited Him saw this, he said to himself, "If this man were a prophet, He would know who is touching Him and what kind of woman she is—that she is a sinner." Jesus answered him, "Simon, I have something to tell you," 'Tell me, teacher', he said. "Two people awad manay to a certain manaylander. One awad him five hundred danarii, and the other fifty. Naither of them had the manay to pay him back, so he forgave the debts of both. Now which of them will love him more?** Simon replied, 'I suppose the one who had the bigger debt forgiven.' You have fully of correctly Jesus said. Then He turned toward the woman and said to Simon, "Do you see this woman?" I came into your house. You did not give Me any water for My feet, but she wat My feet with her tears and wiped them with her hair. You did not give Me a kiss, but this woman, from the time I entered, has not stopped kissing My feet. You did not put oil on My head, but she has poured perfume on My feet. Therefore, I tell you, her many sins have been forgiven—as her great love has shown. But whoever has been forgiven little loves little." Then Jesus said to her, "Your sins are forgiven. The other guests began to say among themselves, "Who is this who even forgives sins?' Jesus said to

Foot's Bible Study

Jeremiah 16:1-17:27

A message of hope with a trio of honorific terms for God - strength, fortress, and refuge. Strength and fortress are related words in Hebrew, like the English "strength" and "stronghold". A refuge is a place of safety from danger. Jeremiah knew that his only place of strength and safety was in God. The scope of Jeremiah's hope is universal. The Gentiles, among whom the people of Judah would be exiled, would come to the God of Israel in fulfillment of the promise of *Genesis* 12:1-3. (16:19-20)

God makes it clear why we sin, it's a matter of the heart. Our heart is inclined to sin from the time we are born. It is easy to fall into the routine of forgetting and forsaking God. But we can still choose whether or not to continue in sin. We can yield to a specific temptation or we can ask God to help us resist temptation when it comes. (17:9-10) "The Heart" refers to the mind, the source of thinking, feeling and action. (17:9)

Our society admires assertiveness, independence and defiance of authority. In a relationship with God, these qualities become stubbornness, self-importance, and refusal to listen or change. Left unchecked, stubbornness becomes a way of life hostile to God. The people's response to God's warning (v. 11) is similar to that in verse 17:23, they rebelliously pursued their own ways. "Hopeless" describes the despair people felt concerning obedience to God. These feelings were the direct result of the evil heart that is characteristic of people who continually turn away from the Lord and His ways. (18:2)

1 Thessalonians 3:1-5:28

Some people turn to God with the hope of escaping suffering on earth. But God doesn't promise that. Instead, He gives us power to grow through our sufferings. The Christian life involves obedience to Christ despite temptations and hardships. (3:4)

There is more to Christian living than simply loving other Christians. We must be responsible in all areas of life. Some of the Thessalonian Christian's had adopted a life of idleness, depending on others for handouts. Some Greeks looked down on manual labor. So, Paul told the Thessalonians to work hard and live a quiet life. You can't be effective in sharing your faith with others if they don't respect you. Whatever you do, do it faithfully, and be a positive force in society. (4:11-12)

Paul's prayer for the Thessalonians is that they may be sanctified in all aspects of their life, spirit, soul and body. Every part of a Christian's life should bear evidence that he or she is set apart as Holy to God. This will result in being "blameless at the coming of our Lord Jesus Christ". Christians are already saints in the sense that they have been set apart to God. Paul exhorts the Thessalonians to express holiness in this life so that the Lord would approve of their conduct upon His return. "Blameless" does not mean sinless, but free from causes for reproach and regret. (5:23)

Psalm 83:1-18

Sometimes we must be humbled by adversity before we will look up and see the Lord. We must be defeated before we can have the ultimate victory. Wouldn't it be better to seek the Lord in times of prosperity than to wait till His judgment is upon us? (83:13-18)

Proverbs 25:15

Being patient and soft spoken can get you much farther in life than you might think. (25:15)

(Luke 11:9-13) Just ask Jesus to baptize you in His Holy Spirit with the evidence of speaking in tongues, your heavenly language. Sad to say, I got 17 more years added to my already 12 year sentence, from which I was supposed to be released July of 2020.

Well, I know you don't know me but I guess I can give you some insight about me and my life. You're the first pastor I'm going to give my testimony too. I'm sure you've heard many, from many a good men.

I read a book after I renounced my almost 20 year membership to the Mexican Mafia. The book was a testimonial book called "Rescued not Arrested" by a man named Roger Munchian. On page 198 of that book he wrote about me and my old colleague J."C"G. They changed our names in this book, but the information given in it was pretty much on point. They tried to charge me and "C" for that particular hit. I went back to the Fed's back then in 2002 then got out again in 2009. I'm not sure if you met "C" when we were in 4th Avenue but anyways I think he mentioned you to me while I was there.

I've been back here in the A.D.O.C. since 2011. I started off here in the state prison system in 1990. Then I went to the U.S.P. in 1995 at the young age of 24. I did two tours in the Fed's, in 5 different states. I was coast to coast putting in what we call "work" as I'm described doing in the previous mentioned book. Anyhow, on to the present.

I have been here in the 'Renouncers Unit' for almost a year now. I first received your newsletter while I was in Browning recovering from a near death experience that changed my life Wade. I used to think of myself as one of the strongest men I knew, until that dreadful day I was given a "Hotshot" of pure fentanyl. That one "shot" killed the deadly man I use to be, and brought back the new born again man I am today! I've been reading my Bible daily since then.


Your writings in your newsletter have inspired me as well as other Christians I come across. Today, my family call me a miracle lol. God changed me! I'm so 'Grateful For So Much' in my life now. But nothing compares to our Lord's mercy, grace and most importantly, His forgiveness I feel inside of me today. Man, after this testimony, I feel like we're good friends now! Ha! Ha! Praise God! At least brothers in Christ! As I said at the beginning of this long over-due letter, it's been a long time coming for me Wade. I'm now 52 years old and yet I'm grateful for being here sharing my some-what testimony with the Therewith for Shriet. I was inspired by a fellow Christian brother here with me, J.A.
