AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 1. OF ORDINANCE NO. 232 AMENDING THE DEFINITION OF NUISANCES PROHIBITED WITHIN THE CITY OF ROLLA, NORTH DAKOTA.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ROLLA, NORTH DAKOTA:

Section 1. Section 1 of Ordinance No. 232 of the City of Rolla is hereby amended and re-enacted to read as follows:

"Section 1. If any person shall suffer or permit any grass or weeds to grow until the same becomes unsightly and offensive to the neighborhood or a fire hazard, or shall suffer or permit any cut or fallen tree or trees, unused or dilapidated or junk automobile, truck, machinery, refrigerator, equipment or appliance, refuse, used lumber or any other material or thing under such conditions that the same becomes unsightly and offensive to the neighborhood, or any unsanitary condition or any condition dangerous to public health, to remain upon any street or alley, or upon any grounds or premises belonging to or occupied by him, except grounds used in the business of buying or selling junk, so as to become an unsightly condition and offensive to the neighborhood, or so as to become dangerous to public health, or so as to be dangerously attractive to playing children, the same shall be deemed and is hereby declared to be a nuisance; and such owner or occupant shall be subject to the penalty hereinafter defined, and shall be subject to a like penalty for each and every day such nuisance shall continue after the first conviction.

Section 2. Effective date. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect and take effect immediately upon its final passage and approval.
