The LVHS is busy in April. This **Saturday, April 9<sup>th</sup>**, we will attend the La Verne Heritage "Spring Fling" Faire as a vendor selling t-shirts, books, and vintage collectables. The Faire will be open from 10am-3pm and is located at Heritage Park at 5001 Via De Mansion in north La Verne. We will repeat our opportunity to sell items and meet the public on **Saturday, April 23<sup>rd</sup>**, from 8am-12pm, at the Community Yard Sale in the Bonita High School parking lot. On **Monday, April 18**<sup>th</sup>, I will attend a City Council meeting to receive the 2021 Jack Huntington Pride of La Verne award for outstanding volunteer service. We have a glass display case at Hillcrest, filled with artifacts from the Palomares family. It is complimented by a wonderful art display of work by Rose Calderon called *Fragments of a Chicana's Life* in the upstairs gallery. The Welcome Room is located next to the Café in Hillcrest's administration building. You will need to check in at the concierge desk, present your proof of vaccination, and take your temperature in order to access the facility. The Welcome Room is open from 8am-4:30pm daily.
