Flight Line Protocols

- 1) All AMA Safety and Operational rules apply at all times
- 2) If you are flying on the old FM technology, A Frequency Pin is required prior to turning on your transmitter. Failure to do so leaves you, the pilot liable for any damage caused to another members plane due to a crash. The new technology of 2.4 GHz does not require a Frequency Pin.
- 3) Pilot's must be in one of the 5 flight stands while flying.
- 4) When going on or across the taxiway or runway for any reason, announce "**ON THE RUNWAY**" loud enough so other pilots can hear you.
- 5) When taxiing on to the runway, announce "**COMING OUT**" loud enough so other pilots can hear you.
- 6) When landing, announce "**LANDING**" on your downwind leg loud enough so other pilots can hear you.
- 7) When you are dead stick, announce, "**DEAD STICK**" loud enough so all other pilots can hear you. Dead stick landings take priority over all others.
- 8) Non-pilots and or children must stay behind the pit area unless accompanied by an adult.
- 9) Please follow the Posted Flight Pattern and avoid the restricted flight zone.
- 10) All pilots must have a "FIRE EXTINGUISHER" with you at all times when flying.
- 11) Clean up after yourself when you are done flying. Put your tables and chairs away.
- 12) When backing into a parking space, be sure to keep as close and safely as possible to the car next to you to ensure space for everyone.
- 13) RC Cars or Trucks are only allowed on the Taxi Ways and Runway when there are no pilots on the Flight Line.
