Just a couple of quick reminders that **tomorrow (Friday) is the deadline** for your kids to be members or to be signed up on the website in order to compete AND for your school's entry to be online.

Your school's entry online means –

- *You have your kids registered in their events.
- *You have your JUDGES registered (some of you have put in no judges yet).
- *You scroll down on the grid page with all your entries on it and put in your titles, etc. of your interp scripts and your Oratory/Informative speeches.
- *You have the School Consent sheets and the Congress division sheets in my hot little hands (I'll be at KHSSL Debate and Speech, in Tab at both; Danville HS fax is 859-936-8401; or you can scan and email to me).

The website will be locked late Friday night.

Any nominations for Student or Coach of the Year are also due Friday.

At registration or before you must turn in

- *Any money you owe national office
- *Your entry fees
- *Paper copies of your Oratory/Informative speeches with signatures
- *Single Entry Letters of Intent
- *Interp Bibliographies; for POI, just type in the title online and then give me a sheet that looks like an MLA Works Cited page for each POI
- *Any Harlen Hamm or Susan Moore nomination letters

That's it for me for a while. I'm going to step into Danville coach mode instead of KYNSDA guy for the state tournament, but I'll be glad to answer any questions in person at the contest or by email after KHSSL. Good luck to everyone at State, especially those of you who bring extra judges to NSDA (because you have good karma!).
