Sean Pevsner was one of the first students with disabilities to take mainstream classes in the Arlington Independent School District. He went on to major in Greek and Latin at UT, while making significant contributions to the university's community. He graduated in 1998, receiving several awards for his advocacy and contributions to the university. Mr. Pevsner then graduated from UT Law School in 2004. In 2005, Mr. Pevsner worked with Disability Rights Texas. While there, he assisted people with disabilities in obtaining equal access to education, employment and community services. Mr. Pevsner complemented DRT's services, not only by providing legal assistance to these individuals, but also by teaching them self-advocacy skills. In 2012, Mr. Pevsner established a firm with his best friend, Mark Whitburn. Their firm, Whitburn & Pevsner, PLLC, practices ADA, FHA, IDEA, and probate and guardianship law.
