POOL FILTER SAND IS NOT PLAY SAND

One problem with using pool filter sand in play areas is the danger from contaminants the sand has collected from the pool water. They are the same contaminants you come in contact with whenever you get in the pool but pool filter sand contains a much larger concentration of them. The same applies to paint, oil and other liquids; they could all pose a health risk.

Another problem is the composition of the sand itself. Rather than containing a whole host of minerals, as beach and play sands do, pool filter sand primarily consists of crushed silica quartz. The dust from this type of sand is a Class 1A carcinogen that can cause a fatal lung condition called silicosis. This is obviously not something in which you want your children to play. It's isn't safe for pets either and is not the best choice of fillers for cat litter boxes.

Because of the contaminants it contains, pool filter sand should never be left in a pile in the yard. If you can't find a use for it around the house and you don't want to truck it to a disposal site, the best way to deal with it is to dig a hole in the yard or garden and bury it. If you choose this option, be sure you locate it far from drainage areas, because flowing water will wash it into the ground and the soil covering the hole will collapse, leaving a depression that you'll have to cover with more topsoil.

FLOOD PREVENTION



In his practice he recommends a combination of EPA +DHA combination, with at least 60% EPA for major depression. He is more cautious in patients with bipolar depression.

Wondering if Omega-3's can help children and adolescents with depression or aggressive behavior? Many medical authorities say yes. If any of these conditions are a concern, please research this supplement. In closing, on a personal note, Omega-3s (fish oil) has worked wonders for my dry eyes. I don't have a problem if I take Omega-3s. What a relief that is!!!




Woodwind Lakes' Midnight Songsters



You probably know the Mockingbird is the Texas State Bird. You may not know it is also the state bird of four other states – all located in the South which is the range of the mockingbird. (How odd that its full

name is Northern Mockingbird!) They are among the most common birds you will see in our area yet they add much delight with their singing which can sometimes carry on into the night. If you hear a bird late at night – singing over and over – you are undoubtedly hearing a mockingbird. The mockingbirds that sing at night are single males, perhaps practicing their songs in order to improve their chances of attracting a female.



They typically do this from February through August and again from September to early November. They are especially vocal on moonlit spring nights.

Most songbirds learn all the songs they will ever sing before they are a year old but the mockingbird continues to expand his collection throughout his lifetime. They learn the songs of other birds and incorporate them into their own songs. Mockingbirds also sometimes "sing" the sounds of people whistling, frogs croaking, car alarms and sirens. A male may have two distinct repertoires of songs during the year and can learn up to 200 songs throughout its life. The mockingbird was given its name because of its ability to mimic the calls of dozens of other bird species. In fact, the mockingbird's Latin name, Mimus polyglottos, means "many-tongued mimic."

These gray birds, lighter underneath, with white patches on their wings and tail are frequently seen sitting high on tall shrubs, poles, or utility lines. Around your yard, you can also look for them running or hopping along your mowed lawn. Occasionally you may see them on the ground with wings outspread, giving a "wing flash" display, where it half or fully opens its wings in jerky intermediate steps, showing off the big white patches. No one knows why it does this but it may startle insects, making them easier to catch.



The mockingbird is also known as a fierce protector of its nest and environment. It is sometimes seen swooping down on a dog, cat or predator that may be venturing too close to the bird's protected territory.

Our Northern Mockingbird is known for its intelligence. A 2009 study showed that the bird was able to recognize individual humans, particularly noting those who had previously been intruders or threats. Also, birds recognize their breeding spots and return to areas in which they had greatest success in previous years.

No wonder we take joy in being surrounded by this beautiful and vocal bird!
