Mayor Frank would like to thank the citizens of Greenwood for their patience and overwhelming support during this trying time.

He is working diligently toward water restoration efforts. Water pressure at the main pumps has increased by 60 % today.

The Mayor has placed a request with the Office of Homeland Security for additional drinking water, along with non-potable water, portable washing machines and showers. Current estimated time of arrival is Tuesday/Wednesday. An announcement will be made when these supplies arrive. Supplies are limited to customers of the Greenwood Water System. Proof of residency will be required.

As we continue to assess the damage, we are repeatedly locating leaks in the lines. So far, all leaks have been on the customer side of the meter. Once these leaks are located, we are isolating them.

The Town of Greenwood is asking that residents who receive service avoid unnecessary water usage and prioritize conservation.

RESIDENTS SHOULD REPORT ANY KNOWN LEAKS as soon as possible by calling the Greenwood Emergency Water Line at 318-208-4693.

Daily updates will be given via press release, and the Town of Greenwood Facebook Page as well as placed on the doors of town hall.

Please remember that once your water is restored, we will remain on a BOIL ADVISORY until further notice. You should boil your water for ONE FULL MINUTE before consuming. Thank you all for supporting our community during this challenging time.
