### **Purpose:**

To provide guidance and outline the minimum appearance standards of the Largo Fire Rescue Cadet Program.

### **Personal Appearance and Grooming:**

- a) Hair will be neat, clean, trimmed, and well groomed, and will not hang over the ears or collar. Hair in front will be groomed so the it does not fall over the eyes. The acceptability of the hair style will be left up to the discretion of the post advisor.
- b) Sideburns will be neatly trimmed and will not extend below the lowest part of the earlobe. They will be of even width, not flared and will end with a clean shaven horizontal line.
- c) Mustaches must be neatly trimmed and shall not extend below the corner of the mouth or over the upper lip. Bush mustaches, spit-curls, beards, goatees, etc. will not be accepted.
- d) Members shall not wear excessive or gaudy jewelry. Male members will not wear earrings at any unit function. Females are allowed one earring per ear stud or post type only. Chains may be worn as long as the chain does not hang on the outside of the uniform. No facial jewelry of any kind.
- e) Sunglasses worn while in uniform will not have mirrored, metallic, or wraparound lenses. Frames will be black or brown in color only. Sunglasses will not be hung on the shoulder lapel of the uniform.
