

### **Lynnfield Street Lights: Facts Sheet for Homeowner's**

1. Cobra overhead lights, like our neighborhood entrance lights
2. Decreases suspicious activity in the neighborhood, according to NCCPD, Cpl. Hester.
3. Increases property value.
4. Slight increase in yearly property taxes. Taxes will go to paying for powering of lights.
5. Overhead lights will be installed on 3-4 new poles on each street.
6. Power for lights will be from aerial power lines. One power line will come from backyard pole to street pole, and subsequent street poles will be wired from first pole.
7. Delmarva pays for the installation and maintenance of the lights & poles.
8. If the lights are approved, the lights cannot be moved for 3 years.
9. We cannot chose where poles will be located and we cannot chose how many will be installed. It is an ALL or NONE situation.
10. EVERY Homeowner has the opportunity and right to sign the petition either YES or NO.
