## **Lynnfield Street Lights: Facts Sheet for Homeowner's**

- 1. Cobra overhead lights, like our neighborhood entrance lights
- 2. Decreases suspicious activity in the neighborhood, according to NCCPD, Cpl. Hester.
- 3. Increases property value.
- 4. Slight increase in yearly property taxes. Taxes will go to paying for powering of lights.
- 5. Overhead lights will be installed on 3-4 new poles on each street.
- 6. Power for lights will be from aerial power lines. One power line will come from backyard pole to street pole, and subsequent street poles will be wired from first pole.
- 7. Delmarva pays for the installation and maintenance of the lights & poles.
- 8. If the lights are approved, the lights cannot be moved for 3 years.
- 9. We cannot chose where poles will be located and we cannot chose how many will be installed. It is an ALL or NONE situation.
- 10. EVERY Homeowner has the opportunity and right to sign the petition either YES or NO.
