

## Pearl Lake Report for July 7th Lake Meeting

7/6/2018

First day out (5/25/18) had 8 total boats with none known to be used on another water body within the year, basically it was all people who live on the lake putting their boat on the lake for the season. The first weekend 5/26 and 27, where the same no boats known to be used on other water bodies this year, again mostly all locals putting their boats on the water for the season. With 12 boats total for those 2 days. After the first weekend traffic has been pretty light from the landing, With 23 boats entering or exiting in total for all my hours after 5/27 as of 7/6. There have been 4 boats used on another water body within the past 5 days. With about 7 boats where the person was unsure if it had been on another lake, or didn't say if it had been or not. From my first day on the landing (5/25) until 7/6 there were 25 boaters that had previously spoken to a CBCW person and 12 that hadn't. Although most everyone who I spoke to knew about the general message of CBCW. There was a total of 43 boats entering or exiting from the start until 7/6. Everyone I have spoken to has been reasonably open to questions and information, just a couple acting rushed and impatient. But in general everyone has been pretty friendly. The boats that had been used recently had been used on Winnebago lake, Channel lake, and Big Hills lake. I have seen the police head out on the lake several times just before the 4th and the 2 days after a well.
