ABRAHAM'S FINAL EXAM (Genesis 22:1-19)

- 1. WHAT WE CLING TO THE MOST IS USUALLY WHAT GOD ASKS US TO RELEASE
 - What we cling to the most, often becomes like an idol in our lives
 - TANGIBLE: Possessions, Vocation, Family, Identity, Power, Position, Dreams, The "PAST," Relationships
 - EMOTIONAL/INTERNAL: "Control;" "Fear;" "Self;" "Security;" Maslow's Hierarchy of Needs
- 2. WHAT WE RELEASE, GOD OFTEN REPLACES WITH SOMETHING OR SOMEONE FAR MORE VALUABLE
- 3. WHEN GOD REPLACES, HE OFTEN BLESSES & REWARDS WITH UNIMAGINED JOY & **EXPERIENCE**
- 4. WHEN GOD BLESSES, HE EXPECTS THAT OTHERS WILL BE BLESSED TOO (Genesis 12:1-9) "Blessed to be a blessing"

ARE YOU READY FOR YOUR NEXT TEST?

- God "tests" not to tear down, but to build up
- God "tests" to show us (not Him) that we're ready for the next STEP of life & faith

WHAT DO WE LEARN?

- 1. The Life of Christian FAITH is a JOURNEY
- 2. The Life of Christian Faith is a LIFE-TIME
- 3. The life of Christian Faith is not easy & it's full of RISKS (Proceed at your own risk) ©
- 4. The life of Christian Faith is full of trials and tests often allowed or placed --- so that God may help lead us to greater awareness and dependence upon God
- 5. The life of Christian faith includes unimagined blessings and rewards ... and grace for the day that we may live and THRIVE AND THAT the world may be blessed thru the Spirit of God in us


