Crystal Place HOA Pool Rules

- 1. Use of the pool is at your own risk. <u>NO LIFEGUARD IS ON DUTY!</u> Diving is prohibited at all times
- 2. By law, an adult must accompany children under **14** years old. If you are not **14**, you may not use the pool without an adult. A single adult (age 18) may supervise four (4) children at one time.
- 3. Individuals under **18** years of age may not supervise or be responsible for other children. RESIDENTS WITH BABYSITTERS ARE ALLOWED ONLY CHILDREN OF RESIDENCE TO BE IN THEIR CARE. Babysitters MUST be **18** years of age.
- 4. Profanity, horseplay, or harassing behavior will not be allowed in the pool area. At the HOA sole discretion, anyone suspected of being intoxicated or under the influence of drugs will be asked to leave the pool area.
- 5. No smoking allowed in the pool area.
- 6. Loud radios are not allowed in the pool area. Please use proper earphones as to not disturb others.
- 7. Please only use unbreakable containers (NO GLASS) in the pool area.
- 8. Rafts and other inflatable devices will not be allowed due to the size of the pool.
- 9. For the protection of all residents, use of the pool is prohibited with an infectious disease, a cold, nasal or ear discharge, open sores, or bandages of any kind.
- 10. Regulation bathing suits must be worn in the pool. Cut offs are not permitted. All residents not toilet trained must wear appropriate swim diapers.
- 11. Pets are prohibited in or around the pool area by health regulations.
- 12. Responsible FOOD eating (ie. Snack crackers, fruit, fruit snacks, etc.) is permitted in the pool area. Ordering pizzas or eating meals, etc. at the pool is not permitted. All acceptable food MUST be kept away from the water, and trash must be disposed of properly in provided trash cans.
- 13. Ropes and rings are provided for the safety of those using the pool. Do not sit on the rope or use the rings as toys.
- 14. HOA reserves the right to refuse access to the pool if, in the HOA's sole discretion, the health and safety of the residents of the community may be at risk.
- 15. Pool keys must be presented at all times. Failure to produce a pool key will result in the person being asked to leave the pool area.
- 16. Pool hours are 10:00a.m. to 9:00p.m. no exceptions, without advance approval of the HOA.
- 17. Resident will be allowed (2) guests at one time. Resident must accompany guests at all times when using the pool.
- 18. GIVING OUT THE KEY OR ALLOWING SOMONE ELSE TO USE YOUR POOL KEY IS PROHIBITED, AND YOUR POOL USAGE WILL BE TERMINATED.
- 19. These rules are to be strictly observed and will be enforced by the HOA. Violations of the rules will result in verbal and written warnings, and notification of the parents for violators under 18 years of age. More than 2 violations from one home will result in termination of pool privileges for the remainder of the season.
- 20. Residents caught damaging any pool property (ie. Chairs, restrooms, etc.) will have their privileges terminated for the rest of the season and a police report will be filed.
- 21. All residents must shower before entering the pool.
- 22. The HOA reserves the right to make such other policies as may be necessary to protect the premises and preserve good order therein.
