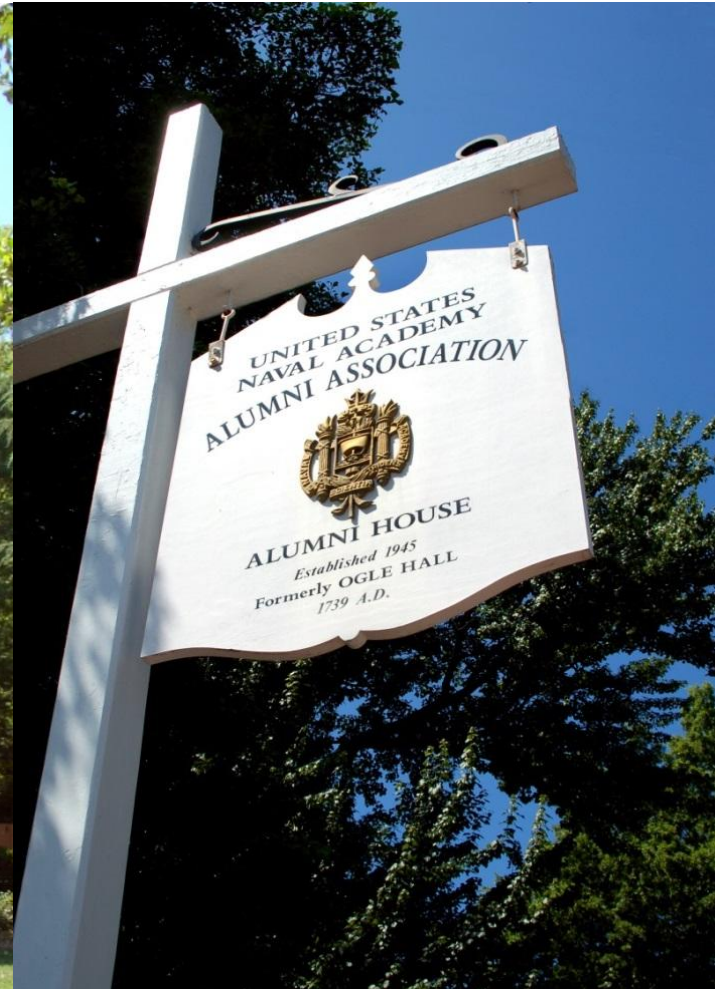

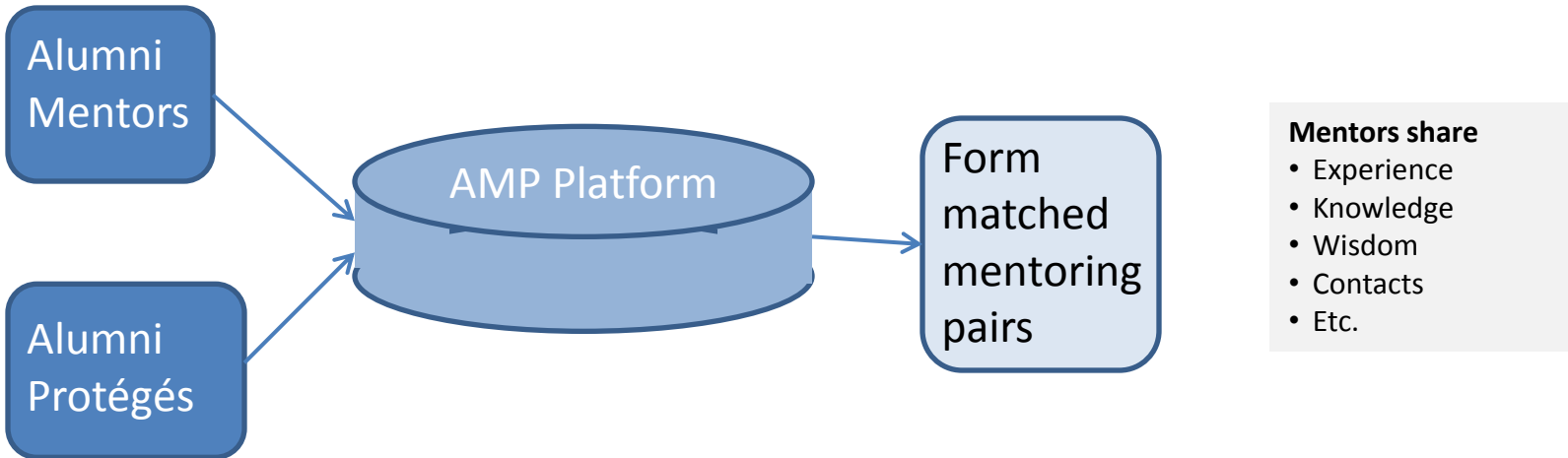


1. Protégés and Mentors input profile data

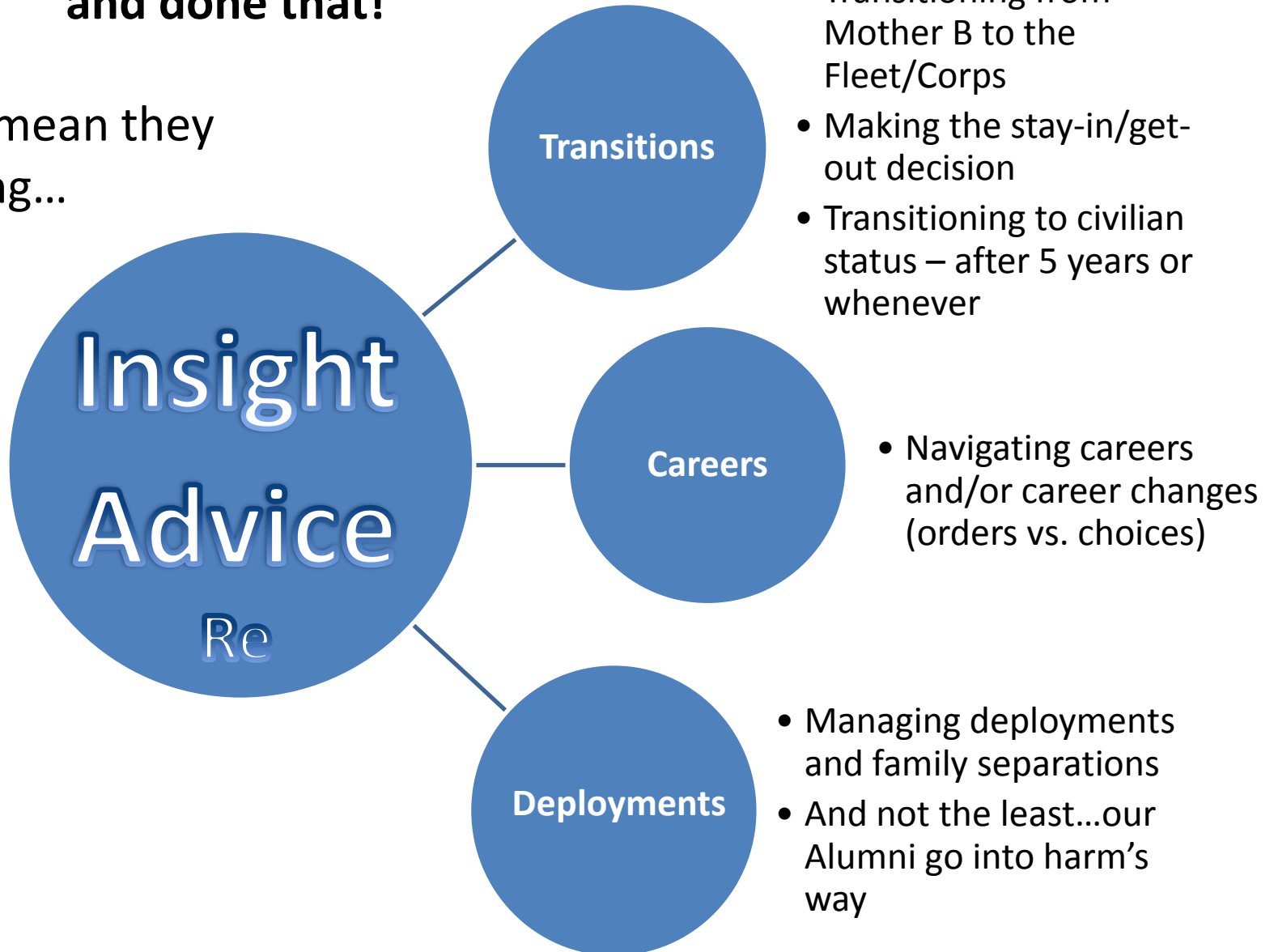

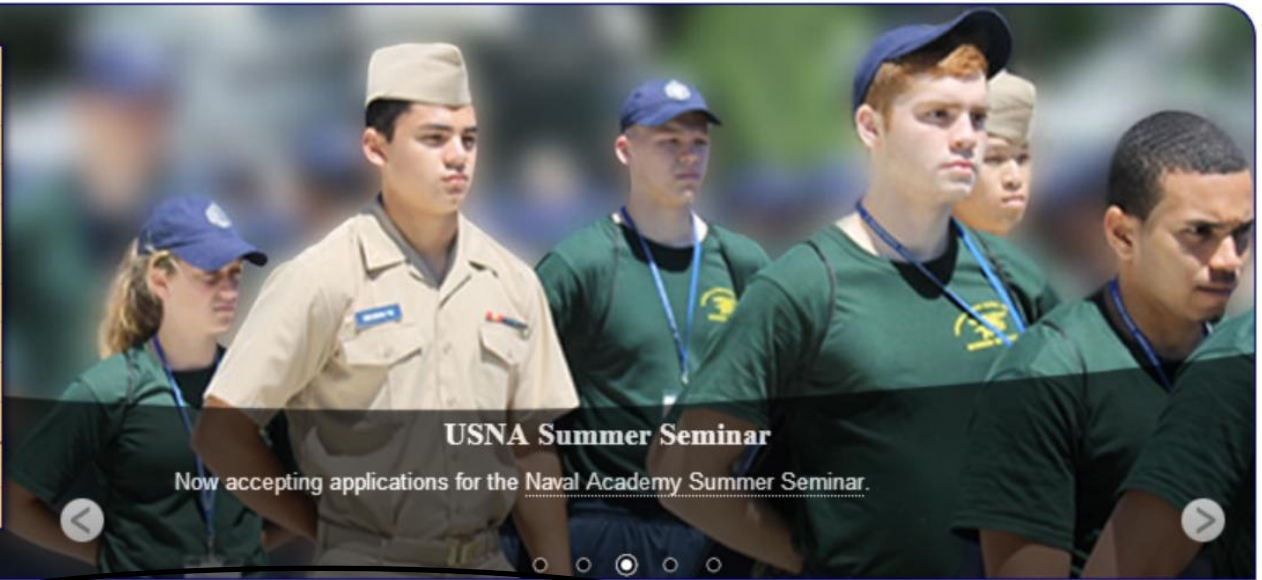

Logistical Hurdles

- **Weather Alts (Color Parade, Graduation, Garden Parties)**
- **Blue Angel Traffic impact**
- **USNA Parking and Access**
 - **1 stadium Parking Pass per family (week). Extra cars / 5\$ day**
 - **Utilize USNA busses or park downtown**
- **Medical Support (Civilian vs Military)**
- **Tickets**
 - **Outdoor unlimited (only 6 in Company area, over flow unlimited, top 10% / legacy – stadium field seating)**
 - **Indoor Graduation (4 per family)**
 - **Indoor Color Parade (4 per family / only 4 companies)**
 - **Supes Reception (4 + 1 MIDN)**
- **FYI: Graduation streamed on usna.edu website or on the Pentagon Channel (local hotels provide coverage)**

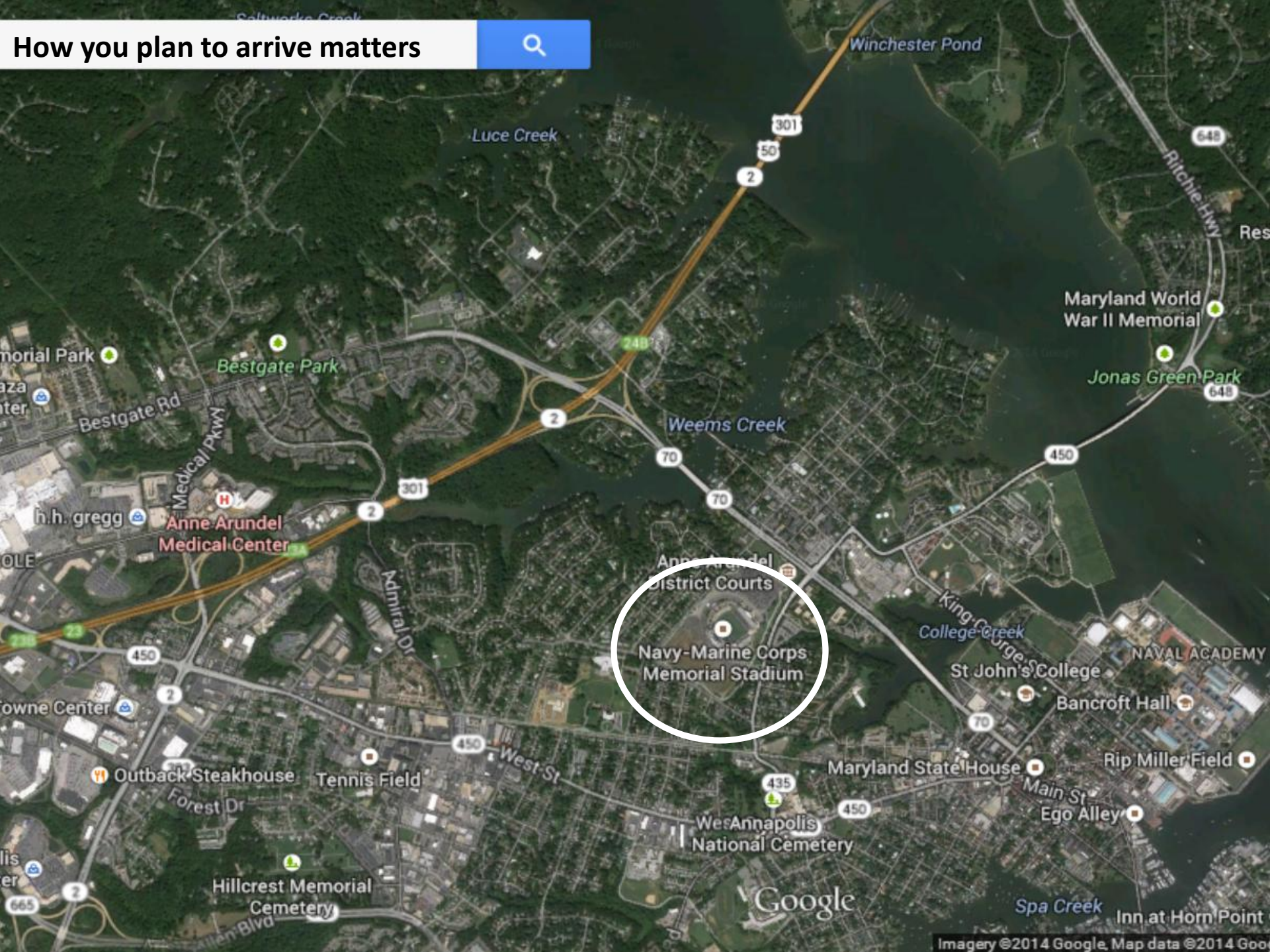
Managing Expectations

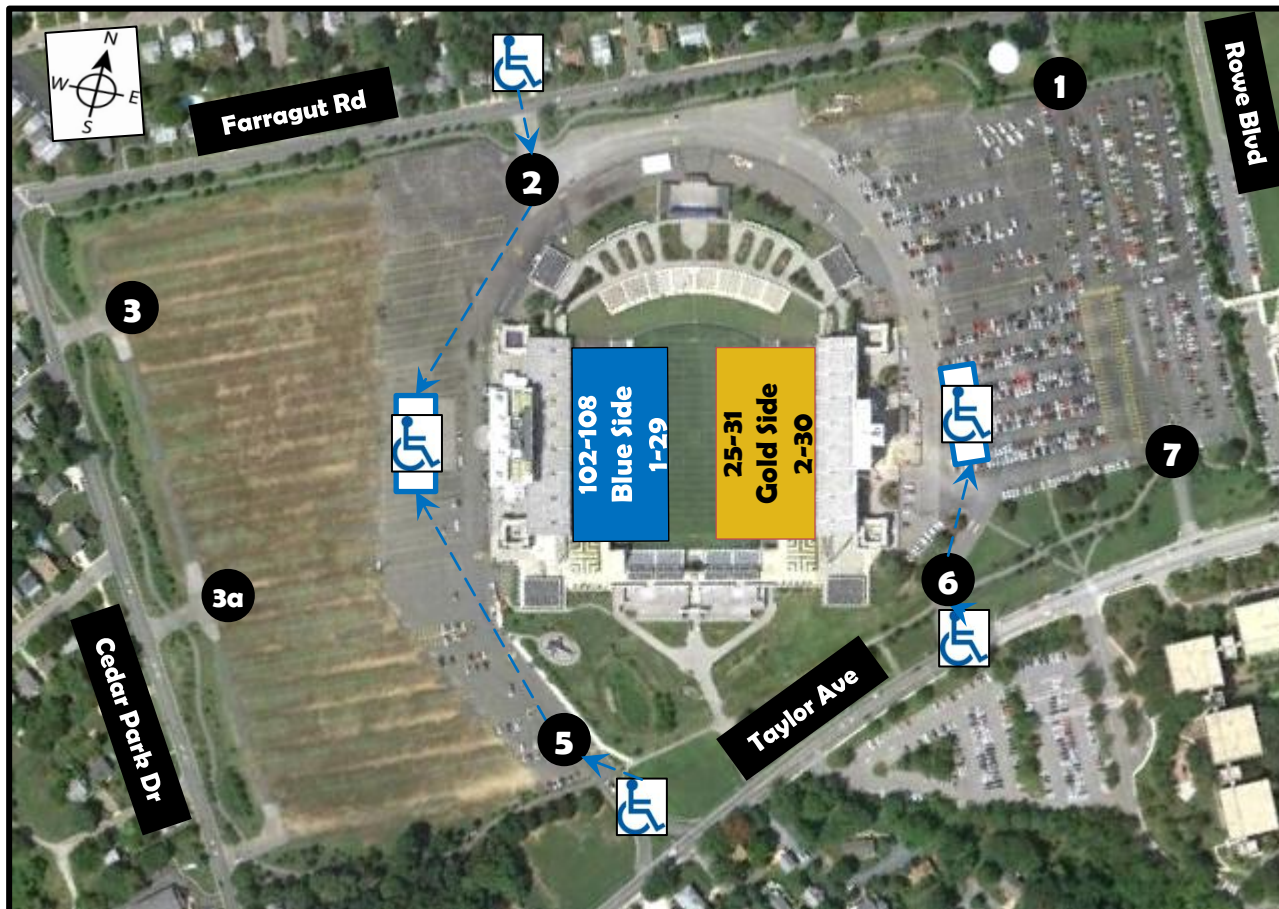

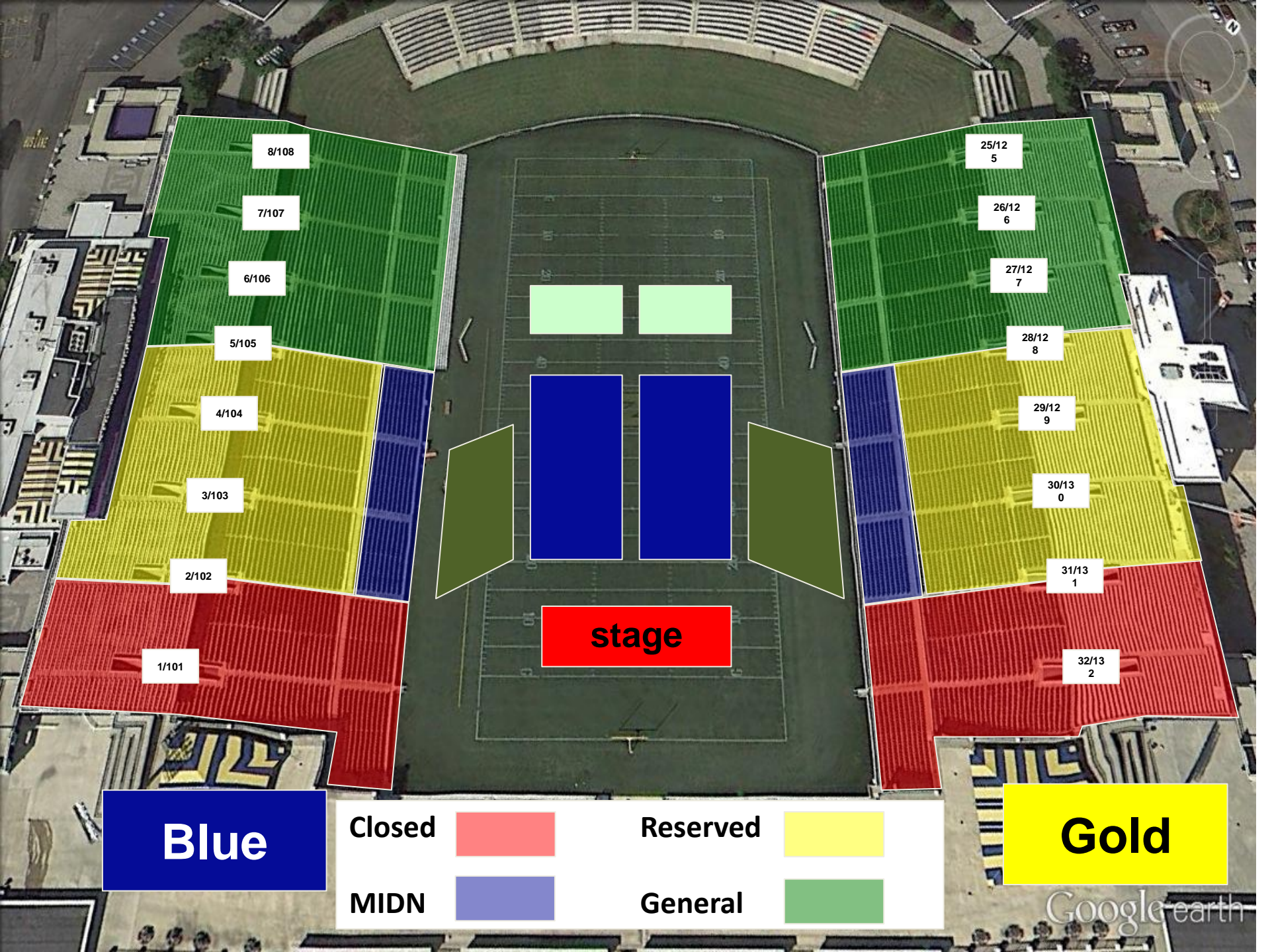
Wheelchair ramps and seating are adjacent to Sections 1, 8, 25, and 32.
