
- Weather Alts (Color Parade, Graduation, Garden Parties)
- Blue Angel Traffic impact
- USNA Parking and Access
  - 1 stadium Parking Pass per family (week). Extra cars / 5\$ day
  - Utilize USNA busses or park downtown
- Medical Support (Civilian vs Military)
- Tickets
  - Outdoor unlimited (only 6 in Company area, over flow unlimited, top 10% / legacy stadium field seating)
  - Indoor Graduation (4 per family)
  - Indoor Color Parade (4 per family / only 4 companies)
  - Supes Reception (4 + 1 MIDN)
- FYI: Graduation streamed on usna.edu website or on the Pentagon Channel (local hotels provide coverage)

- 1230 ~ approx hat toss




## Graduation Ceremony Arrival & Departure Friday, May 23, 2012, 10 a.m.

Wheelchair ramps and seating are adjacent to Sections 1, 8, 25, and 32.


