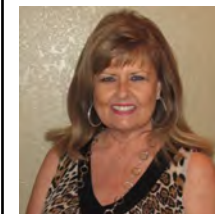


Mary Beth Russo is originally from Rochester, NY and joined Newcomers in April 2014, after moving to Winter Springs with her husband, Dan.

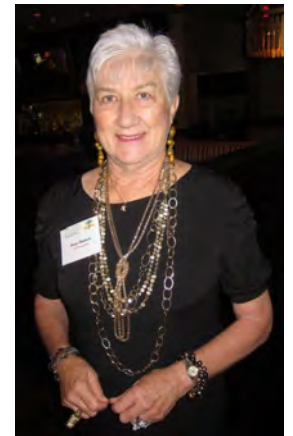
