



BY LAWS OF THE Apostolic Faith Bible College, Inc. Article VII Doctrine

It is recognized that the true church of Jesus Christ consists of all believers who believe in the saving grace of our Lord and Savior Jesus Christ and who have accepted Him as their personal Savior. It is recognized and agreed that no organization or man has been granted authority by the Lord to exclude from or accept anyone into the Kingdom of Heaven, as this is done by Jesus Christ only. It is further recognized and agreed that we as Christians are to love all members of the Body of Christ (Christians), and this love and fellowship derives from the unity instilled by the Holy Spirit. Although differences in doctrinal beliefs and interpretations should not influence our love for one another, adherence to similar doctrinal beliefs and modes of worship have bonded together those of the Apostolic Faith Movement as founded by Charles F. Parham in the early 1900's. The scripture teaches us to adhere to the truth and proper doctrine. The common doctrinal beliefs are essentially as follows.

- * Triune God; Father, Son, and Holy Spirit
- * Creation and Formation
- * Man is basically sinful and in need of salvation
- * Salvation by Grace upon repentance toward God and acceptance of Jesus Christ as one's personal Savior, which is the conception of Spiritual Life
- * Sanctification of the Spirit, Soul, and Body, A second definite work of Grace by the Lord Jesus Christ
- * Baptism of the Holy Spirit; evidenced by the speaking in other languages.
- * Water Baptism (of all believers) by immersion in water in the name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Spirit
- * Sacrament of the Lord's Supper
- * Washing of feet
- * Divine Healing through Jesus Christ for all believers
- * Do not condone divorce and remarriage
- * Destruction of the wicked
- * Conditional Immortality
- * Rapture of the Man Child Class
- * Return of Jesus Christ to earth again; bodily and visibly
- * A ministry supported by tithes and offerings

These doctrines shall be adhered to in the teachings of the Apostolic Faith Bible College, which in addition to other doctrinal teaching approved by the Board from time to time if the are not inconsistent with the above listed basic doctrines.

From The Superintendent....

Recently among the students, a word has become popular. Whenever I mention it, I can expect one or two people to say "woo". The word is used several places in the Bible to describe a resolving of the will of man to the will of God or to cause the perspective of the statement to go from a negative to a positive. The word is NEVERTHELESS. This can be "our word" when the devil whispers (or shouts) in our hearing, "You can't - You aren't - You won't..." we can say, based on the authority of God's Word, "that may appear to be true (from man's perspective), NEVERTHELESS God says.... The devil may say, "I am great," yet we can say that may indeed be true, NEVERTHELESS the Bible says, "Greater is he that is in me than he that is in the world."

Peter used this word in Luke 5:5. After they had toiled all night, Simon didn't want to cast his net again, but he said "NEVERTHELESS at thy word I will let down the net."

Christ used it in Mark 14:36 concerning wanting to do his Father's will. And so I teach. And sometimes it doesn't seem like they are listening, NEVERTHELESS (oops, I said it again) they are.

Concerning the college here, thank you for your continued support. It is very much appreciated and we are trying hard to be good stewards of the finances. God help us to receive a sense of wisdom and direction in these areas.

We, or at least I, am encouraged. I've been pleased with the cooperative attitude of the students and the ability of the faculty to do what they have been called to do. I've been pleased with the spiritual deepening I've seen in some lives that comes from an eagerness for God. I guess the main question though is asked in that song "Is my Lord really satisfied with me?"

The school hopefully continues, first with the intention of training and inspiring laborers for the work of the Lord, wherever and whatever capacity it may be. We have chapel every morning with the aim of getting focused on God. Some of the students have done the speaking and singing. We have had several visiting speakers and what I'm really excited about is some of the nearby Alumni have been speaking and teaching for us. We do need Him every hour. "I am thine O Lord"... I sing. But I wonder? Am I really? And how much of me belongs to Him?

Dear Apostolic Faith Family,




