Day 1 – U.S./Italy: Depart from U.S. for your flight to Italy.

Day 2 – Rome / Naples / Sorrento: Upon arrival in Rome (or Naples), proceed to baggage claim. A Jet Vacations representative will meet you once you have cleared customs and then escort you to our hotel. The Amalfi Coast—"Costiera Amalfitana"—extending along the mountainous western coast of Italy is justifiably renowned for its beauty and history. UNESCO describes it as, "an outstanding example of a Mediterranean landscape, with exceptional cultural and natural scenic values. Our hotel offers spectacular views of charming fishing villages and villas nestled in the mountains overlooking the clear Mediterranean Sea. Once you have settled into your hotel, we will go on an orientation tour of nearby Sorrento. Memorably described as "the land of colors and mermaids," Sorrento is known for its fine cuisine as well as its legendary beauty. To help you savor the extraordinary essence of this Italian city, we have planned a welcome dinner at the hotel. (Dinner)

Day 3 – Sorrento / Amalfi Coast / Sorrento: We will enjoy a full-day excursion exploring the enchanting towns along the picturesque Costiera Amalfitana. As we make our way to Amalfi, we will see Positano from above, and glimpse its buildings clinging to the rocks. Amalfi's origins date back to both the Roman and Byzantine Empires. It once rivaled Genoa and Pisa in its maritime importance and still retains its fishing traditions today. The first view of Amalfi is unforgettable, with its tightly packed villas and palaces seeming to tumble down the cliff side into the fishing port and beach below. After, we visit Ravello, one of the most attractive destinations on the Amalfi Coast, with a population of around 2,000. This village perches high above the coast, overlooking the Mediterranean. A renowned musical festival is held in Ravello every year, with classical music concerts taking place in gardens with breathtaking views. We will also have an opportunity to visit Villa Rufolo and the medieval Cathedral. Tonight dinner is served at the hotel. (Breakfast, Dinner)

Day 4 – Sorrento / Capri (Optional Tour (\$125 / per person): The day will be at leisure—a wonderful opportunity to relax and discover the hidden corners of Sorrento. You may choose to join us to an optional tour to the island of Capri. We take this optional tour with a high-speed boat trip from Sorrento's harbor to the remarkable island of Capri. A minibus in Capri will then take us to the city of Anacapri, where we have the opportunity to visit Villa San Michele, home to the famous Swedish doctor and writer Axel Munthe. Upon our return to Capri, we will have time for independent lunch, then walk through Augustus Gardens. Free time in the afternoon will allow us to see the Blue Grotto, a stunning sea cave, as an optional excursion. Dinner is on your own. (Breakfast)

Day 5 – Sorrento Pompeii / Naples / Sorrento: We visit Pompeii today with a local guide. Frozen in time after being buried by the volcanic eruption of Mount Vesuvius in A.D. 79, Pompeii is an extraordinarily unique archeological site. The excavation has helped historians and scientists understand daily life in a prominent coastal city during the height of the Roman Empire. From Pompeii, we travel to Naples, the capital of the Campania region. The history, art, and renowned gastronomy of Naples help to make it Southern Italy's most culturally distinctive destination. Lunch will be an Italian classic—pizza! But this is pizza as only the Neapolitans know. After our meal, we will explore the historical center of Naples. Highlights of our afternoon tour include Old Town, Posillipo, Piazza del Plebiscito, San Carlo Theatre, and the castles of Naples. (Breakfast, Lunch)

Day 6 – Sorrento / Paestum Optional Tour (\$125 / per person): This day will be spent at your leisure—shopping, enjoying Italian ice cream, or having some cappuccino. There will be an optional tour of Paestum. First settled by Greek colonists in the sixth century B.C., Paestum is one of the most famous and important archeological sites in Italy. The ruins in Paestum range from city walls, Greek temples, other religious buildings, the amphitheater, and the Via Sacra. But, at least in Italy, Paestum is equally famous for its buffalo mozzarella. We will visit a mozzarella cheese factory for a demonstration of cheese production. Here, we have a personalized tour of the factory, then enjoy a delicious lunch made with these fresh products. Try their exquisite mozzarella, ricotta, and homemade bread. Return to Sorrento in the afternoon. Dinner is on your own and at your leisure. (Breakfast)

Day 7 – Sorrento / Mt Vesuvius / Sorrento: This morning we explore and tour the beautiful region of Mount Vesuvius, an active volcano. The perfect cone of Vesuvio dominates one of the most beautiful bays in the world, the Gulf of Naples. An alpine guide will escort people interested in reaching the crater with a short 15-minute walk. Afterwards, we stop at a local winery for a demonstration and tasting of local wines. Our farewell lunch will feature local gastronomy. Say goodbye to Sorrento, where you will spend the remainder of your afternoon as you please. Dinner is on your own and at leisure. (Breakfast, Farewell lunch)

Day 8 - Sorrento / U.S.: After breakfast, we will bid a fond goodbye to Italy and transfer to the airport for our return flight home. (Breakfast)

Day 8 - Sorrento/Rome: This morning, you will meet your guide and driver and set off for Rome. Upon your arrival in Rome, transfer to your hotel for check-in, the rest of the afternoon is at leisure and yours to enjoy. The Romans say that, "Rome wasn't built in a day,"—which also means that Rome can't be seen in a day! In fact, one could live in the Eternal City for years and still not see everything that it has to offer. It is hard to say what you will find the most breathtaking: Etruscan tombs, the republican meeting rooms, imperial temples, early Christian churches, medieval bell towers, baroque basilicas or renaissance palaces. Tonight you are on your own for dinner, but you will have no trouble finding local restaurants in this residential area of Rome. Just outside the hotel and around the corner are some lovely places were the locals meet to eat, have a glass of local wine, and enjoy a dish of pasta. Ask your guide or the concierge at the hotel to make a recommendation—they will be pleased to help you. (Breakfast)

Day 9 - Rome: Today we will spend the day exploring the magnificence of the Eternal City on a full-day tour. In the morning, we will enjoy a guided tour of Imperial Rome, the Rome of the Caesars. We also stop at the Roman Forum, the most important archaeological area in the city and once the center of the public life. Of course, we will visit the Colosseum, perhaps the most famous monument of ancient Rome and an impressive testament to her past greatness. We will enjoy lunch in a local family run trattoria to taste the flavors of the "Cucina Romana." After lunch, our tour will continue into the Vatican Museums and the Sistine Chapel. The Vatican Museums and their immense wealth of art, resulting from centuries of papal collections, offer an extraordinary experience. Amongst others, see the great masterpiece of Michelangelo, "The Last Judgment," in the Sistine Chapel. The tour will end once we have visited St. Peter's Basilica to admire the art treasures of the largest Roman Catholic Church in the world, including Michelangelo's Pietà (please note that appropriate attire is required—no shorts or sleeveless tops). Upon return to the hotel, enjoy the remainder of the day at leisure, where you can do some shopping or take a stroll on the Via Veneto. Tonight dinner is on your own. Enjoy your final night in Rome. (Breakfast, Lunch)

Day 10 - Rome/U.S.: After breakfast, say ciao to Rome and transfer to the airport for your return flight home. (Breakfast)

Air arrangements: Fares and schedules are based on regular scheduled carrier service. All applicable airline rules apply and schedules are subject to change. Basic airfares include fuel surcharges, airport departure taxes, passenger facility charges (PFCs), customs or immigration fees, but do not include excess baggage charges and any other airline imposed charges. For mileage accrual information, please contact the carrier directly for details. Air inclusive group packages are non-changeable and non-refundable once deposit has been paid. Rules and fees for canceling and revising airfares vary depending upon the type of airfare purchased. Refundable airline tickets will be processed once the original paper tickets (if applicable) are returned to us via a traceable method of mailing. E-tickets do not need to be returned. Lost paper tickets have no refund value.

IMPORTANT NOTE ON FUEL SURCHARGES: Fuel surcharges imposed by the airlines are valid at time of contract and are included in the price of your tour. As fuel continues to fluctuate, if the fuel surcharges change prior to your departure date, you will be assessed this additional amount.

Cancellation Policies: No charges other than the non-refundable initial deposit are levied for individual passengers canceling up to 120 days prior to the commencement of Jet Vacations LLC services. However, services which have been prepaid by Jet Vacations LLC on behalf of individual clients maybe non-refundable, non-exchangeable, non changeable and/or maybe subject to a cancellation- change fee (e.g. theater tickets, Train tickets, Airline Tickets, Event Tickets, Passes, Entrance fees etc.).

Full cancellation: Failing to pay the contractual deposits (other than the initial deposit) constitutes a cancellation. In the event of non-compliance with the payment due dates, Jet Vacations LLC shall have the right to demand the Customer to immediately pay the outstanding balance. Payment shall then

be received by Jet Vacations LLC within eight days as of the date of Jet Vacations LLC's written request. Should payment not be received within this time limit, the group stay shall be deemed to be canceled by the Customer. In the event of full cancellation of the agreement by the Customer, which is not justified by Jet Vacations LLC's failure to meet its obligations, cancellation penalties shall be invoiced and calculated as follows:

Initial deposit\*\*: non-refundable.

From 119 to 91 days prior to departure: 30% penalty of the total cost per person.

From 90 to 61 days prior to departure: 50% penalty of the total cost per person.

From 60 to 31 days prior to departure: 75% penalty of the total cost per person.

From 30 to day of departure & no show: 100% penalty of the total cost per person.

\*\* Deposit to hold the space and First deposit is nonrefundable. If a passenger cancellation creates a change in the price schedule, the tour price will be revised based on the remaining number of participants. A passenger becoming a single as a result of a partner's cancellation must pay the single supplement.

NOTE: The following non-refundable fees will be added to the penalty charges listed on the cancellation (full or partial) schedule above: Travel protection premiums. Airline tickets - airline penalties, which may be up to 100% of the ticket value. Refundable airline tickets will be processed once the original paper tickets (if applicable) are returned to us via a traceable method of mailing. E-tickets do not need to be returned. Tour Cancelation: We reserve the right to cancel the entire trip (or any component of the trip) for any reason and/or time. In this event, our liability, if any, shall be limited to and liquidated by refunding to each prospective participant the payments made.
