Regular Meeting of the Worthington City Council Monday May 26, 2020 6:30PM. Meeting was conducted in the Worthington Community Center with the option to call in via a Zoom conference call. The City of Worthington reserves the right that the order of the agenda is at the discretion of the Mayor or Mayor Pro-Tem. Mayor, Gary Langel, called the meeting to order at 6:30PM with roll call: Ron Leuchs, Marty Marugg, Steve Engler, Tony Lueck. Chris Smock. Additional attendance: Todd Hosch (Pubic Works), Mike Lansing (Water/wastewater Operator), Jason Wenger (City Engineer), Nate and Morgan Feldmann (residents) attended via Zoom.

Motion by Smock, seconded by Lueck to approve the agenda. Ayes: all, carried. Council reviewed firework permits for Zach Schlichtmann and Marty Marugg as well as a building permit for Jacey Stanbro for cementing the creek on the South side of her property. Manternach advised she directed Stanbro to the DNR to inquire with them if a permit was needed. Wenger looked up current floodplain map and advised in the current map, that area is in the floodplain, however in the new floodplain map which is still pending, that area was taken out. Motion by Smock, seconded by Marugg to approve Stanbro building permit providing that either a DNR permit is produced to the City, or a letter from the DNR stating no permit is needed. Ayes: all, carried. Motion by R. Leuchs, seconded by Engler to approve the consent agenda. Marugg abstained due to conflict of interest. Ayes: R. Leuchs, Engler, Smock, T. Lueck. Carried.

Wenger presented Water Looping Main Plans and council reviewed. Feldmann inquired if the sanitary sewer would be replaced during this project. Lansing advised he would televise this area to review condition. Lansing added that clay pipe typically lasts 100 years and this area is 40-50 years old. Lansing also added he would like to see poly blue core pipe instead of copper pipe. Wenger advised he would make changes and provide plans to Manternach to have in the office and online for citizen review.
