We have included an illustration of the Dedication Plaques to give everyone an image of how they look. The plaques will have a significant placement in the Santuario courtyard as you enter. This phase will begin in the spring of 2024.



This is a picture of the completed mission statue of St. Augustine, just received last week. The life-size bronze depiction has temporarily been placed at the church in Antonito and will eventually be placed at the santuario along with six additional mission statues. The process for the next mission statue will begin as entire donations are complete for each figure. We have volunteers actively seeking contributions for the remaining missions of Ortiz, San Rafael, Las Mesitas, San Miguel, and San Antonio.

In addition to the mission statues surrounding the Santuario and the statue of Our Lady Of Guadalupe and St. Juan Diego at the entrance, walkways will lead visitors to various areas of interest. The placement of new trees will also be available to contributors who are interested in dedicating a tree in memory of a family member similar to what now exists on the New Veterans Boulevard entering the Village of Conejos.

FIRST READING

Manna from Heaven  
Ex 16:2-4, 12-15

Wandering through the desert, living the life of nomads, God's people had to rely on God. The author is a keen observer of the human condition. Human beings can be like ungrateful children who take love and care for granted and complain when things fail to go their way. Prudent parents understand. They know that maturation is a slow process and they help the child on its way to adulthood. God's word in this tradition brings out to us that growing toward maturity in Christ is a lifetime process. As long as we are a pilgrim Church, wandering through the desert of life, we must work hard to attain such maturity. But God is with us, providing bread and quail, in other words, giving whatever in his infinite wisdom and love he knows we need.

A New Self  
Eph 4:17, 20-24

"That is not how you learned Christ." Note that Paul does not say "how you learned about Christ." No, you learned Christ whom you accepted as a person in faith, with all the values he stands for. Christianity is not primarily a doctrine to go by; it is a person-to-person relationship with our Lord. Partaking in the Eucharist, the bread of life, should help us to "learn Christ" ever more intimately.

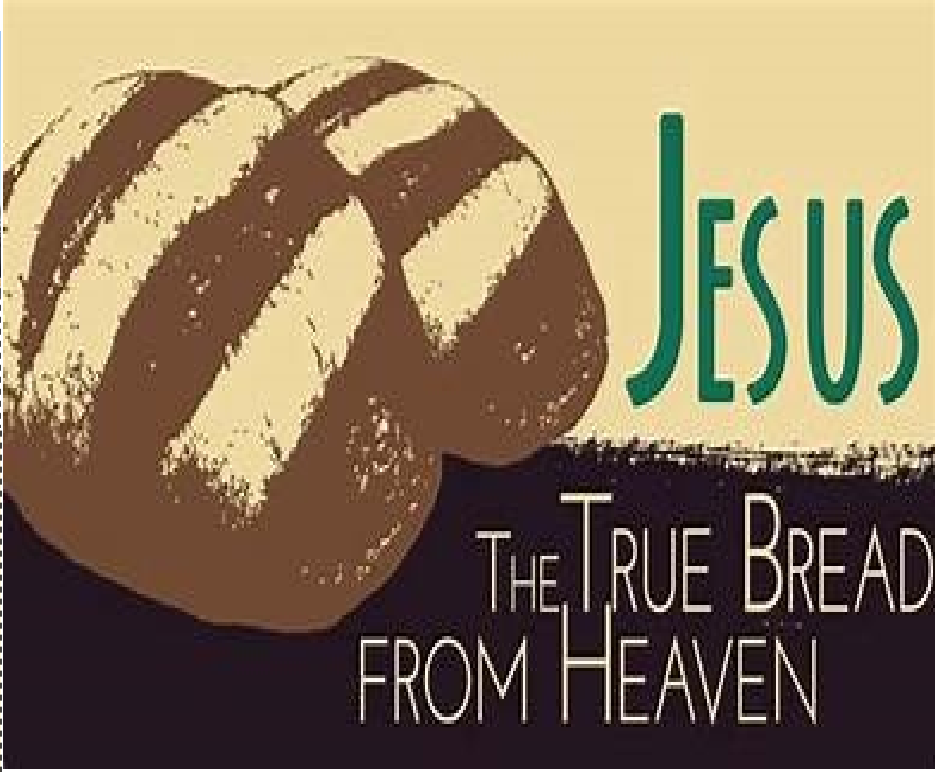

Theme: The Lord Gave Them Bread from Heaven

We can look at flowers in various ways. For example, I can see them from the viewpoint of a florist, a painter, or an artist who loves to arrange them. When I see flowers in church, I take them as symbols of life. When I glimpse flowers around a casket, regard them as symbols of sympathy and signs of the resurrection. If flowers are sent to me as a present, they become for me a symbol of attention, love, and friendship; accordingly, I will love these flowers and think of the person who did me this honor. We should develop a feeling for symbolism since it plays such an important role in religion. Water, bread, wine, salt, yeast, fire, light, rain, dew, thunder, lightning time and again these are used to impart a message and when properly understood they do so more efficiently than theoretical concepts can do. Symbolism contains an intuitive (suggestive) power that appeals not only to the intellect but to the total person, heart and mind. Today's readings utilize the symbolism of bread to bring out the message that God wants to feed us, to take care of us on all levels of human existence. "The Lord gave them bread from heaven" (Responsorial Psalm).
