2019 WORKSHOPS

"IT'S ALL ABOUT YOU" GIRLS SUMMIT WILL HOST 5 MAJOR WORKSHOPS ON SATURDAY, OCTOBER 19, 2019

- 1) "SHOW ME THE MONEY"** – This workshop is designed to give students the knowledge and resources they need to (1) Use the services and products of financial institutions such as banks, credit unions and savings and loans (2) Create and implement a budget (3) Distinguish the difference between "needs and wants" (4) Use credit and borrow money responsibility (5) Protect their financial rights and safeguard their money (6) Recognize available options for paying for college, purchasing a car and renting their first apartment.
- 2) "LOVE, SHADE N' LEMONADE"** - Bad Girls, Love n Hip Hop Atlanta, Love n Hip Hop New York, Mean Girls. What do these shows have in common? What are the differences between Who's got love and Who's gettin Shade? Come join us in real talk about some common themes of these popular shows!
- 3) "RESPECT ME, I'M WORTH IT!"** - is an interactive workshop designed to equip young women between the ages of 13-19 years old with the tools that support embracing their inner beauty, inherent strengths, and owning their right to demand respect from people with whom they develop relationships with. Participants will also explore the advantages of knowing their expectations in relationships, and will engage in small group discussion to explore these issues.
- 4) "#DOIMATTER?"** – discusses self-esteem as it relates to race, ethnicity, and status. It will describe the challenges young girls facing the status quo with regard to beauty, body image, speech and presentation. It will provide tools and affirmations to allow young women to be able to stand for themselves in times of adversity and disrespect surrounding who they are as women.
- 5) "EDUCATED, EMPOWERED & EQUIPPED"** – The girls will celebrate the talents and skills the each possess and learn how to use those talents in service of their purpose. The girls will learn the importance of a great education and its influence on the trajectory of their lives. The workshop will be led by experts and advocates to motivate our girls to take their education seriously and prepare them for the real world. Educating girls is directly linked to positive outcomes!
