COVID-19 Safety Procedural Changes Updated April 2022

#### **Workshop Class**

Class sizes will be limited to 18 students each.

Temperature checks will be conducted at the beginning of each class. Anyone with a temperature of 100 degrees or more will be sent home. Parents/Guardians are required to stay until a temperature check has been taken for their child.

Hand Sanitizer will be available to students and instructors during the workshop.

#### **Snacks**

Bottled water will be provided for students to consume during the class.

#### **Sanitation**

High touch surfaces will be sanitized before classes each day, these include bathroom fixtures, sink handles, doorknobs, makeup tables, makeup area chairs, house seats, and railings.

#### **Sharing**

Sharing time will be open to parents/guardians and family members of the students.

#### **Public Restrooms**

All high touch surfaces will be sanitized including door knobs, sink handles, toilet handles, soap dispensers, and paper towel dispensers.
