

ALL-YOU-CAN-EAT PANCAKE MEAL - HIGH SCHOOL CAFETERIA (7 AM - 2 PM) & MASONIC LODGE (9 AM - 3 PM): Adults - \$7; Children 5-12 - \$6; 4 & Under are Free.

1861 BUILDING - Now the Marathon Area Historical Society's Museum - filled with exhibits and opportunities to chat w/Historian and area folks!!
