


CORVETTE GALS' LUNCHEON - Feb. 23/24

Corvettes of Durham Cruise Etiquette

То:	All Members

The following are some of the rules of etiquette and tips that are practiced for all cruises and outings:

- 1. **Bring** a walkie talkie with you if you have one.
- 2. **Always** start with a full tank of gas
- 3. **Attend** 'driver's meeting' immediately before starting cruise. You will get information on which walkie talkie channel to be on as well as pertinent info about the cruise.
- 4. **Keep** a safe distance from the vehicle in front of you without leaving large gaps.
- 5. **Be** mindful of your driving so that you are not 'kicking' back stones/gravel, etc.
- 6. **No** passing of other Vettes
- 7. **Keep** the car behind you in sight at all times. If the car behind you gets caught at a red light or stop sign or if you can no longer see the car behind, pull over so that we can regroup when possible. The exception to this may be when travelling through a city with a lot of stop lights/signs. In this case, refer to your map, proceed on and regroup when convenient and safe to do so.
- 8. **If** the car behind you pulls over to the side of the road, you should also pull over as a sign to those ahead of you that there is a problem
- 9. **When** stopping, do not stop on the road pull to the side for safety
- When changing lanes or pulling back onto the road, the rear car should pull out to 'block' so that everyone ahead can get back onto the road easier.
- If possible have the cell phone number of the cruise organizer so that if need be, you can contact them. You might also want to provide your cell number to them prior to the cruise start.
 - The above are suggestions to help make cruising easier for everyone, however it is important to keep the 'rules of the road' and safety in mind at all times.



The first of these experiences, known formally as the "MSP Driving Academy: Level 1", consists of a combination of classroom sessions, paddock activities, and on-track driving exercises.


