Minutes of October 9, 2018

Board meeting @ Athens Village Hall

The Board met on October 9, 2018 at 5pm at the Village Hall. Meeting was called to order by Mayor Brown a Quorum was recognized.

The meeting was opened with Prayer and Pledge of Allegiance both by Alderman Smock.

The floor was opened for any comments: None was given.

The minutes of the September meeting was read with no clarifications. Alderman Smock made a motion to accept as read, motion was seconded by Alderman English.

The financial report was presented to the board after review, motion carried to accept as presented.

New Business:

Ordinance 2018-4 Titled Animals. After some discussion the Ordinance was tabled at this time.

Resolution to authorize the application to be made to the State Bond Commission was voted on with a motion by Alderman Faulk and it was seconded by Alderman English. It was brought to a vote and passed 3-0.

Ordinance 2018-3 Titled for loan/or grant to Replace Wastewater Treatment Plant. This Ordinance was given to the board at the September meeting to review. A motion was made by Alderman English and seconded by Alderman Faulk to take it to a vote it passed 3-0.

Purposed Ordinance 2018-5 Titled for the incurring of debt not to exceed \$480,000. This Ordinance was given to the board for review to vote on at the November meeting.

Old Business:

The board accepted Mr. Caldwell's resignation. The board moved into discussion of other applicants and a motion was made by Alderman Smock to hire A. J. Swayze and the motion was seconded by Alderman Faulk. It was brought to a vote and passed 3-0. Mr. Swayze will start as new contractor for the Village Water and Wastewater treatment system on Nov.01, 2018.

With no other business on the agenda the meeting was adjourned by Mayor Brown.
