

Member golf tourney attracts 100 players

Former Port Orange Police Chief Jerry Monahan and his playing partner Larry Bishop were not to be outdone as they also posted a score of net 52 to win

first place in the second flight. Long time MGA member Herb Dodson "paired" up with Tom Pair to capture second place in flight one with a net score of 53. Third place (net 54) in flight one went to one of the original MGA members Ray Pinkley and his partner Bill Peebles.

Another original MGA member Ken Humbert and his playing partner Rich Valarose posted a net 53 for second place in flight two. Ron Sanders and Ray Smith took third in that flight with a net score of 56.

Steve Kuester obviously found the par three's to his liking as he won closest to the pin on holes number seven and 16. Jake Bianco won the award on

hole six and Bill Whitley won it on hole 12.

All members were treated to a luncheon catered by The Tavern restaurant. President Tony Delmonte conducted a short meeting after the luncheon and announced Bill Schell was named MGA Player of the Year for 2016.
