Legion Ladies

The “Legion Ladies” is a group of members of our Post Legion Family that work with the post commander to improve our post. The Legion Ladies were instrumental in raising funds for the hall floor, raising over \$11,000 in less than a year and the current project, raising funds for kitchen renovation (stove, sink, floor, etc), has raised over \$5,000. We donated \$500 to the Rush-Henrietta food shelf and \$500 to the 2016 USMCR Toys for Tots campaign, and \$100 to the Blue Star Mothers. All of these donations were made in the Post’s name, not the Legion, the S.A.L. or the Auxiliary, but the post Legion Family. We have provided financial aid to one Legion family in need, assisted our Cub Scout pack in sending members to camp that would not otherwise have been able to go, and have sent fruit baskets and flowers to every ill/injured/hospitalized member of the Legion Family that we have been made aware of.

The Legion Ladies immediate goals are to continue to raise funds for the kitchen renovation, to continue to donate to the Rush-Henrietta food shelf and Toys for Tots, to stand ready to aid those members of our Legion Family who require it, to support our Scouts, our ill, injured and hospitalized family members and our community.

It doesn’t take anything other than a willingness to work and a desire to accomplish something. If you want to be one, ask one. We have a need for more kitchen help coming up in September. The Legion Ladies raise funds through the Tuesday dinner sales, special events, and general donations.
