

I had heart surgery in May. I was fortunate to be under the care of wonderful medical professionals. I was so grateful to have countless people praying for me. I could feel the mercy of God pouring over me.

I mention this in light of the theme for our Diocesan Mission Collection: "To announce the mercy of God, the beating heart of the Gospel."

As Pope Francis explains it, mission carries mercy to the far corners of the world - reaching the poor, the sick, the forgotten and the dispossessed.

Many of them do not have access to basic health care, much less skilled surgeons. Many of them have never known the grace of a faith community that cares for them.
