

RESOLUTION NO. 2022-03

A RESOLUTION OF THE TOWN COMMISSION OF THE TOWN OF JUPITER INLET COLONY, FLORIDA, ESTABLISHING AND LEVYING A TAX UPON ALL TAXABLE PROPERTY, REAL AND PERSONAL, IN SUCH TOWN FOR THE OPERATION AND CONDUCT OF THE VARIOUS DEPARTMENTS OF SUCH TOWN, FOR ALL NECESSARY AND EXTRAORDINARY EXPENSES CONTEMPLATED FOR SUCH TOWN DURING THE FISCAL YEAR COMMENCING ON THE 1ST DAY OF OCTOBER, 2022, AND ENDING ON THE 30TH DAY OF SEPTEMBER, 2023; CERTIFYING TO THE COUNTY PROPERTY APPRAISER THE MILLAGES TO BE LEVIED FOR THE YEAR 2022/2023; REPEALING ALL RESOLUTIONS IN CONFLICT HEREWITH; PROVIDING A SAVINGS CLAUSE; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

WHEREAS, the Legislature of the State of Florida, by the enactment of Chapter 69-54, Acts of 1969, abolished the tax assessing and tax collecting responsibilities of the various municipalities within the State and placed those responsibilities in the respective County Property Appraiser and County Tax Collector excepting only special assessments; and

WHEREAS, the County Property Appraiser is required to assess all property within the Town of Jupiter Inlet Colony at its just value; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Florida law, the County Property Appraiser is required to certify to each municipality the total assessed valuation of all property located within the municipality; and

WHEREAS, the Town of Jupiter Inlet Colony is required to certify to the County Property Appraiser that millage or those millages to be levied for all

purposes for the tax year 2022/2023.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE AND IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED BY THE TOWN COMMISSION OF THE TOWN OF JUPITER INLET COLONY, FLORIDA, THAT:

Section 1: For the purpose of raising revenue for the payment of all appropriations of such Town of which amount the sum of \$2,635,581 has been appropriated from ad valorem taxes to be collected for the fiscal year commencing on the 1st day of October, 2022, and ending on the 30th day of September, 2023, there is hereby levied, assessed and established a specific levy or tax of 5.56 mills on each thousand dollars of valuation upon all taxable property, real and personal, in such Town, except upon homesteads up to the value defined by law and exempted by Article X as amended of the Constitution of the State of Florida.

Section 2: The hereinabove set forth millage is the millage to be levied for all purposes for the tax year 2022/2023 for the Town of Jupiter Inlet Colony, Florida, and is so certified to the County Property Appraiser pursuant to Section 200.065(4), Florida Statutes. This millage rate exceeds the rolled-back millage rate by 12.26 (%) percent.

Section 3: All resolutions or parts of resolutions in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

Section 4: Should any section or provision of this Resolution or any portion

thereof be declared invalid by a court of competent jurisdiction, such decision shall not affect the remainder of this Resolution.

Section 5: This Resolution shall take effect immediately upon passage.
