Paid to the C.E. Byrd/Magnet Bookkeeper. Students must have receipt to enter class.

Students will receive **30 hours** (including **15 min** break each day) of class room instruction and **8 hours** of driving experience. Students will need a **notebook** to take notes to be used as a study guide for the Louisiana Driving Tests administered by the Department of Motor Vehicles.

Students are allowed **ONLY 1 absence** NO EXCEPTIONS. More than 1 absence will result in the student dropped from class. (NO REFUND). Students **MUST** attend the last day to complete FINAL EXAM.

Students are under the same rules/regulations while on the Caddo Magnet High School campus as they are during regular school hours. ***Students will not be allowed to leave campus once they arrive.***
