## **Directions: From the EAST to 636 Winegardner Road, Schellsburg:**

At the light in Schellsburg, continue <u>West on Rt. 30</u>. Look for Rose Road in 1.8 miles. <u>Make a right onto</u> <u>Rose Road</u>. Follow Rose Road for about a mile. <u>Make a right onto</u> <u>Hoover Road</u>. <u>Make the first left onto Winegardner Road</u> (at the white Allegheny Mennonite Church) and go about a mile to the round house on the right. You will be climbing up the mountain.

**To get to the picnic pavilion**: continue on Winegardner Road past the house and driveway several hundred feet to the row of trees. Make a right just before the row of trees. We will have it marked WOSA. Follow this grassy road down and below the lower alpaca pasture and you will see the pavilion.

## From the West (Somerset County) to 636 Winegardner Road, Shellsburg:

Turn before you get to Schellsburg, making a Left onto **Rose Road**. Follow Rose Road for about a mile. **Make a right onto Hoover Road**. **Make the first left onto Winegardner Road** (at the white Allegheny Mennonite Church) and go about a mile to the round house on the right. You will be climbing up the mountain. **To get to the picnic pavilion, follow directions above.**
