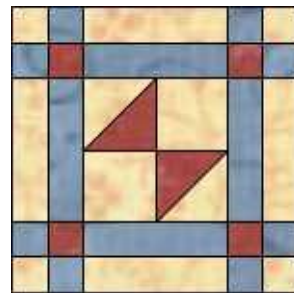


# Block of the Month ~ January 2016

Block Size: 12 1/2" x 12 1/2"

"Odds and Ends"

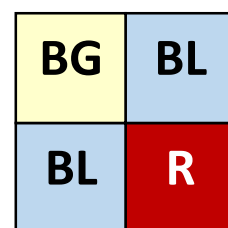
Directions make one block.



| Fabric          | Amount      | Cuts  |
|-----------------|-------------|---|
| Red (R)         | Fat eighth  | Four 2" squares; one 3 7/8" square  |
| Blue (BL)       | Fat eighth  | Eight 2" squares; four 2" x 6 1/2" strips;                                      |
| Background (BG) | Fat quarter | Four 2" squares; four 2" x 6 1/2" strips; one 3 7/8" square; two 3 1/2" squares |

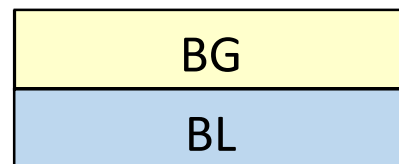
**Step 1:** Make four 4-patch units using the 2" squares.

For each 4-patch use 1 background, 2 blue and 1 red. The unit will measure as a 3 1/2" square.

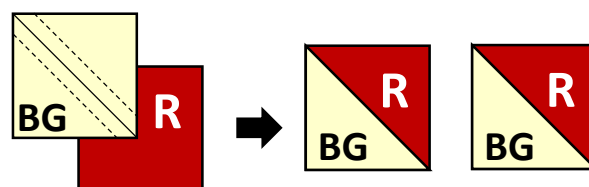


**Step 2:** Make four side units using the 2" x 6 1/2" strips.

For each side sew together a blue strip and a background strip. The unit will measure 3 1/2" x 6 1/2".

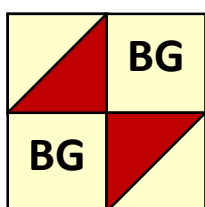


**Step 3:** Make two half-square triangles using the red and background 3 7/8" squares. Finished HSTs will measure as 3 1/2" squares.



**Step 4:** Make the center 4-patch unit

using the two HSTs and the two 3 1/2" background squares. The unit will measure as a 6 1/2" square.



**Step 5:** Put it all together!
