

The storefronts of the historic **Estes Brothers Grocery** building (left), **Hayden Store** (center), and **Floyd's Grocery** buildings have been painted and await finishing touches ahead of our planned March opening of Phase I. This will include an expanded Art & Science Center, new Visitor Center, expanded Artisan Gift Shop, expanded archives, and new foundation offices. Phase II will include a heritage center that will be triple the size of our current museum space.



Interior framing is nearly complete. We were able to reuse walls from inside the building which saved on lumber costs and recycled these precious resources. Our facility will be energy-efficient, visitor-friendly and historically preserved.

Our project is on-time and under-budget. Here is a view of our project budget:
