How did I become Village President? I know that has been a question on a lot of minds. I wanted to explain how this all came about.



In April, Jay Waldvogel was elected Village President. Shortly after the election, Jay decided to move to Florida. Jay resigned from the position in early June. This left the Village President position vacant. Because

Sheridan is a "Village" we are held to the governing laws of a Village. The following is the ordinance that directs the actions taken when a President or trustee leave office.

62.13 Vacancies; filling; special elections; procedure; expenses. Sec. 13. A vacancy occurring in the office of president, trustee, or any other elective office shall be filled by appointment by the council, and the appointee shall hold office until the next regular village election.

In nutshell, this means the current board was able to nominate a trustee to the position of Village President. The best explanation I can give is this: If the President were to leave office the Vice President would step up. There wouldn't be another election. We, the trustees, are like 6 Vice Presidents in this case.

I was nominated by several trustees and I accepted the position. This was not anything I had expected and I am truly humbled by the support and confidence that the other trustees have in me to do the job. I promise I take this position very seriously, and will do it to the best of my ability.

Now for a little about me and my background. I attended the University of Texas and have a bachelor's degree in business management. I have been a finance manager for both large corporations and small companies. I have owned 3 of my own companies: Decorating Spaces, The Sweat Shop, and currently Strothman Automotive. I have dealt with government entities in several of my past jobs, so I am familiar with what I like to call "the red tape road".

I grew up in Minocqua, WI, another small town like Sheridan. I have lived in Sheridan since 2004, and have grown to love the community and the people. I have seen businesses struggle and unfortunately some even close. Hardship has hit many small towns and Sheridan is no different. Reminders-Village Residents:

Village of Sheridan Golf Cart Ordinance:

No Golf Cart shall be operated on any sidewalk in the Village of Sheridan. No golf cart may be operated on a roadway in the Village unless, at a minimum, it has the following: brakes, a steering apparatus, tires, a rear-


view mirror, red reflectorized warning devices in the front and rear, a slow moving emblem on the rear of the golf cart, a headlight that emits a while light visible from a distance of 500 feet to the front, a tail lamp that emits a red light visible from at least 100 feet from the rear, brake lights, turn signals, and a horn. When operated on a roadway, a golf cart shall have its headlight and tail lamps lighted as required by Section 12-201 of the Illinois Vehicle Code and its operator shall obey all Traffic Rules and Regulations as described in the Illinois Vehicle Code and Ordinances of the Village of Sheridan. **Any minor child on a golf cart shall be seated in a forward facing seat and secured with a lap belt, seat belt of other form on safety restraint.**

<u>Residents</u>

You may have noticed these signs popping up around the village. Surf Broadband is currently in the process of obtaining a permit with the Village of Sheridan for fiber optic work throughout town. The following questions and answers will help explain this:

Why are we installing these lines? Is this for the school or is it a service that will be offered to all residents? This build is to offer internet service to the residents of Sheridan.

What services will be provided? Surf Broadband is offering 1 gig internet at a very competitive price on a month to month basis, without commitment for a particular period of time. They offer other, less plans as well if someone doesn't need the full gig service.

Will this require yards to be dug up? The fiber lines will be bored underground and will be dug to install the handholes as well as bore pits which will be restored to as good or better as the crews found them. These handholes and bore pits will be dug and installed in the right of way.

What is the time frame for work completion? 6-8 weeks once the project has begun.
