WHAT IS REPRESENTATION?

- The act of representing
- The state of being represented
- The expression or designation by some term, character, symbol

I beseech you therefore, brethren, by the mercies of God, that ye <u>present</u> your bodies a living sacrifice, holy, acceptable unto God, which is your reasonable service.

1 Corinthians 12:22-27 - ²² On the contrary, the parts of the body which seem to be weaker are indispensable, ²³ and those parts of the body which we think less honorable we invest with the greater honor, and our unpresentable parts are treated with greater modesty, ²⁴ which our more presentable parts do not require. But God has so composed the body, giving the greater honor to the inferior part, ²⁵ that there may be no discord in the body, but that the members may have the same care for one another. ²⁶ If one member suffers, all suffer together; if one member is honored, all rejoice together. ²⁷ Now you are the body of Christ and individually members of it.

Genesis 43:26 - When Joseph came home, they brought into the house to him the **present** which they had with them, and bowed down to him to the ground.

Genesis 46:29 - Then Joseph made ready his chariot and went up to meet Israel his father in Goshen; and he **present**ed himself to him, and fell on his neck, and wept on his neck a good while.

Exodus 34:2 - Be ready in the morning, and come up in the morning to Mount Sinai, and **present** yourself there to me on the top of the mountain.

Leviticus 1:5 - Then he shall kill the bull before the LORD; and Aaron's sons the priests shall **present** the blood, and throw the blood round about against the altar that is at the door of the tent of meeting.

Leviticus 8:18 - Then he **present**ed the ram of the burnt offering; and Aaron and his sons laid their hands on the head of the ram.

Leviticus 23:36 - Seven days you shall **present** offerings by fire to the LORD; on the eighth day you shall hold a holy convocation and **present** an offering by fire to the LORD; it is a solemn assembly; you shall do no laborious work.

Numbers 18:28 - So shall you also **present** an offering to the LORD from all your tithes, which you receive from the people of Israel; and from it you shall give the LORD's offering to Aaron the priest.

1 Chronicles 21:26 - And David built there an altar to the LORD and presented burnt offerings and peace offerings, and called upon the LORD, and he answered him with fire from heaven upon the altar of burnt offering.

Ezekiel 43:24 - You shall **present** them before the LORD, and the priests shall sprinkle salt upon them and offer them up as a burnt offering to the LORD.

1 Corinthians 15:15 - We are even found to be mis**represent**ing God, because we testified of God that he raised Christ, whom he did not raise if it is true that the dead are not raised.

Exodus 18:19 - Listen now to my voice; I will give you counsel, and God be with you! You shall **represent** the people before God, and bring their cases to God.
