We are a year on since the transfer of staff from Derbyshire County Council to the new joint venture company, Vertas Derbyshire Limited (VDL).

This happened during the biggest public health crisis in a century. UNISON pushed for the transfer to be delayed so members did not have to go through the stress of the changes while working on the front line to keep our schools and other vital public services clean and safe. Sadly, the council refused.

Since transfer, UNISON has continued to raise your problems with VDL, most commonly around the issues of pay and absence. This has incorporated pushing for better communication and clarity
