Lighting

The six yearly survey of the 80 street lights owned by the Council has revealed that a number of columns are now showing defects due to age. These twelve are planned to be replaced over the coming six months, subject to the availability of County Council contractors. The Parish Council is also taking the opportunity to upgrade aged mercury and low pressure sodium lamps, where replacements are now scare, with energy efficient LED units.

Grit bins - the green ones!

The Parish Council owned grit bins have been refilled (and emptied of unwanted litter!) so are ready for residents' use, on the roads this winter.

Annual Parish Meeting

The Council agreed that in view of the continuing health crisis it was not possible to hold the 'Annual Meeting' in public requiring a 'face to face' format. While legally a virtual meeting could be held it felt that this would preclude many from taking part.

It would assess the position again in March 2021, when hopefully the usual April/May event can be arranged.

Website review / accessibility.

The Council has implemented the requirements of The Public Sector Bodies (Websites and Mobile Applications) Accessibility Regulations 2018 regarding accessibility for people with various disabilities.
