

I can't believe Summer is almost over and the Fall is right around the corner.



Dear Brothers and Sisters:

What follows is: The role of the Priest and the People at Mass: When the Entrance Chant is concluded, the Priest and the faithful, standing, sign themselves with the Sign of the Cross, while the Priest, facing the people, says: In the name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Spirit. The people reply: Amen. Then the Priest, extending his hands, greets the people, saying: The grace of our Lord Jesus Christ...., Or: Grace to you and peace from God our Father and the Lord Jesus Christ. Or: The Lord be with you. The people reply: And with your spirit. (Note there is no hand gesture). Then follows the Penitential Act, to which the Priest invites the faithful, saying: Brethren (brothers and sisters), let us acknowledge our sins, that we may prepare ourselves to celebrate the sacred mysteries. A brief pause for silence follows. Then all recite together the formula of general confession: I confess to almighty God ...in what I have done and in what I have failed to do, And, striking their breast, they say: through my fault, through my fault, through my most grievous fault; Then they continue: therefore I ask blessed Mary ever-Virgin,.... The absolution of the Priest follows: May almighty God have mercy on us. forgive us our sins and bring us to everlasting life: The people reply: Amen. Or: The Priest then says: Have mercy on us, O Lord. The people reply: For we have sinned against you. The Priest: Show us, O Lord, your mercy. The people: And grant us your salvation. The absolution by the Priest follows: May almighty God have mercy on us ... The people reply: Amen.
