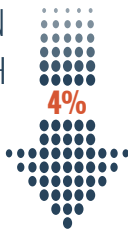

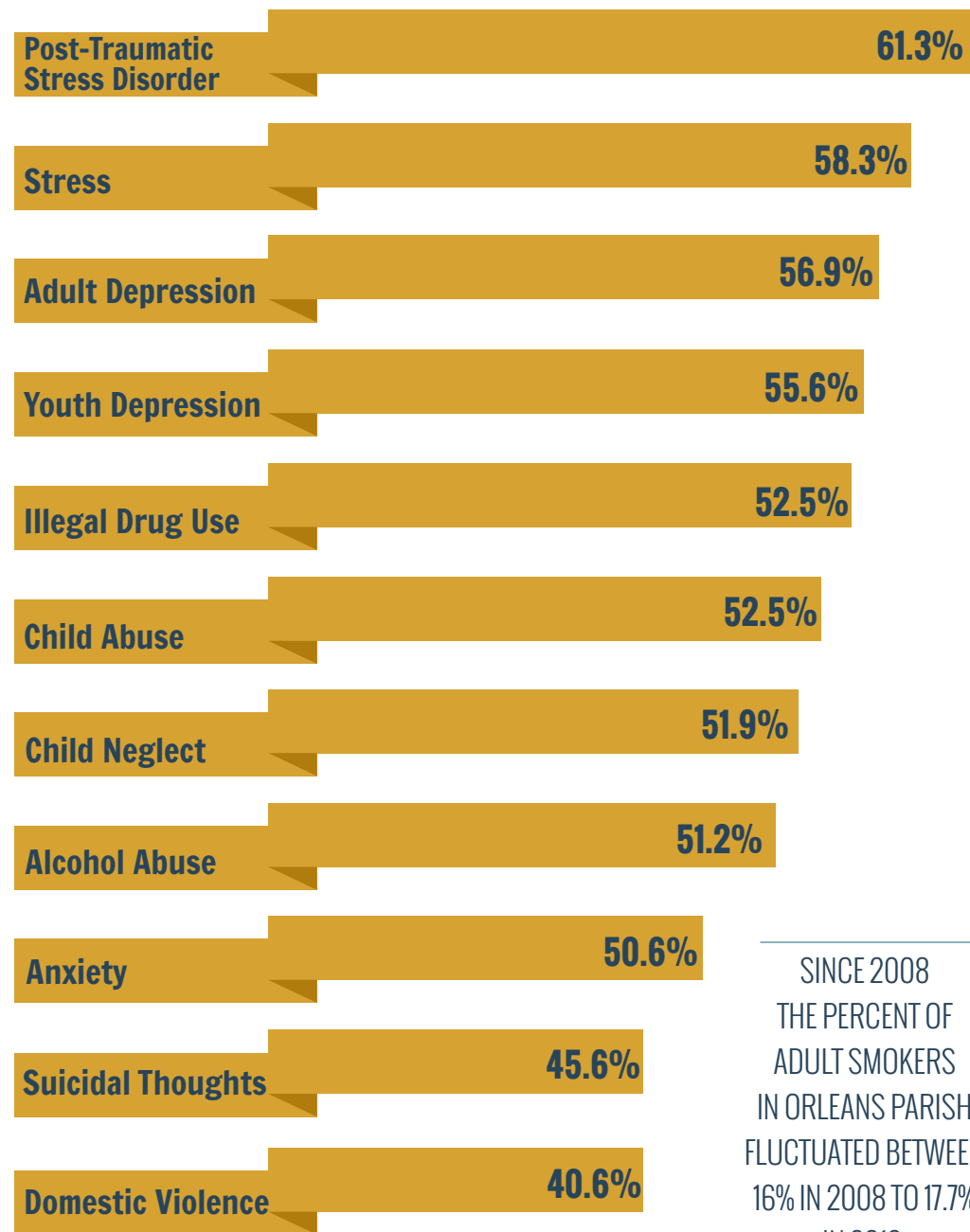
ADULT DEPRESSION IN ORLEANS PARISH DECREASED FROM 19.4% IN 2008 TO 15.4% IN 2012.



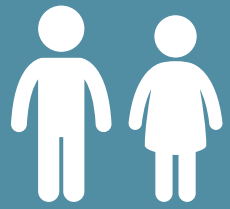

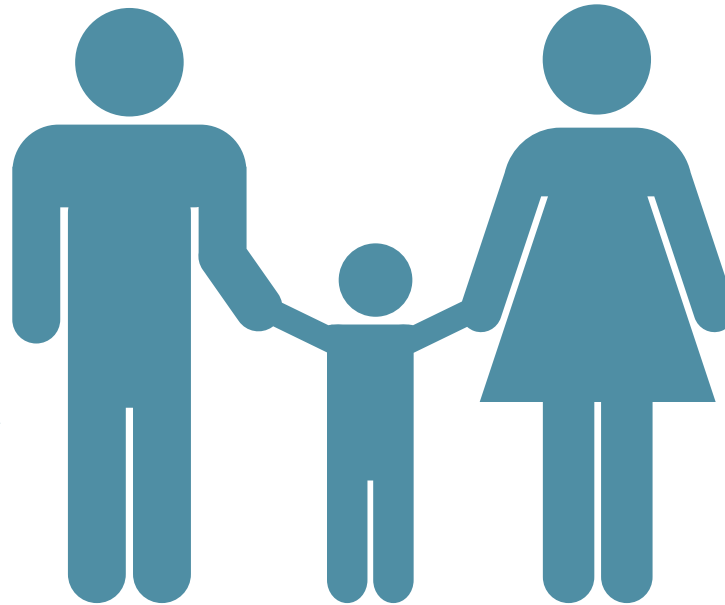
