**MASS READING
RELFECTION**

Aug 19, 2018

**1st Reading Prv 9:1-6
[Divine Food and Drink]**

Personalizing Wisdom and Folly as two women (a figure of speech used in many literatures of the world), the author has both of them invite guests to a banquet. This passage concerns the invitation of Wisdom; verses 13-18 of the same chapter deal with the invitation of Folly to her banquet.

Human beings are free in their choice of where to go. Eating the food of Wisdom and drinking her wine makes human beings live. Sharing the table of Folly, know “that in the depth of the nether world are her guests” (v.18). This reading relates to the Lord’s bouquet in which he himself is the living bread (Gospel).

**2nd Reading Eph 5:15-20
[Discern God’s Will]**

In order not to act like fools and not to continue in ignorance, we should be filled with God’s Spirit and sing praise to the Lord with all our hearts. Our communal worship services should inspire us. We need one another’s inspiration. That is why we should not skip Mass without serious reasons.

Each of us is responsible for an inspiring worship service. We are there together, listen to God’s word together, pray and sing together, partake in the Eucharistic celebration together, not only to get inspiration, but also to give it to others by the mere seriousness of our presence. A Christian alone is unthinkable. Only through togetherness and a sense of belonging do Christians live up to their name.

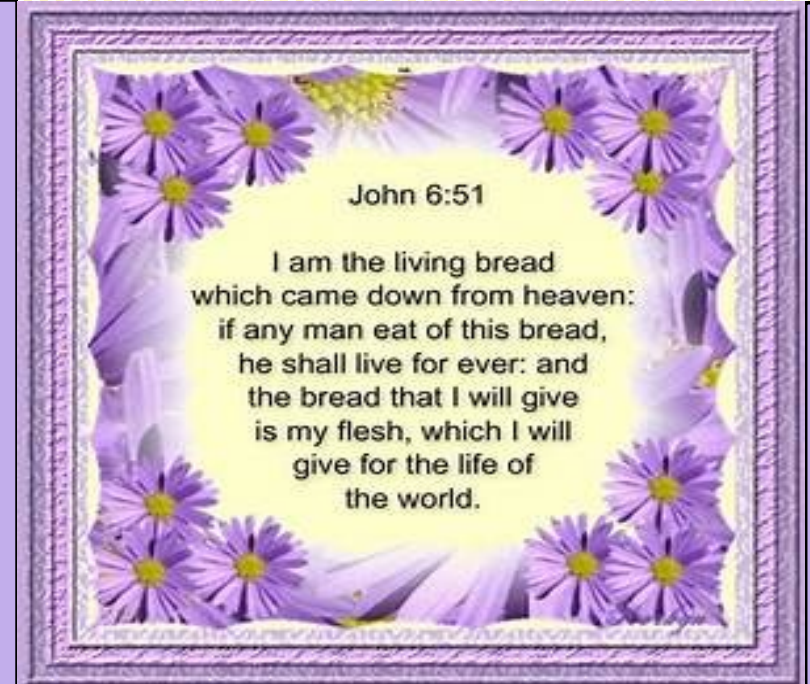

THEME: The Eucharistic Celebration

Absence, alienation, loneliness, communication gaps are the ailments of modern life. We yearn for presence and the loving care of a person who is close by. The great consolation that Christianity offers to mankind, haunted by the threat of alienation, is that God is close by, Emmanuel, in Jesus Christ.

The Lord Jesus “is always present in his Church, especially in the liturgical celebrations. He is present in the sacrifice of the Mass, not only in the person of the minister....but especially under the Eucharistic species. By his power he is present in the Sacraments, so that when a person baptizes it is really Christ himself who baptizes. He is present in the word, since it is he himself who speaks when the holy Scriptures are read in the Church. He is present, finally, when the Church prays and sings, for he promised: ‘Where two or three are gathered for my sake, there am I in the midst of them’ (Mt 18:20)” (Vatican II, Constitution on the Sacred Liturgy,7).

Whenever you feel the need of presence, and perhaps have been disappointed on the human level, know that Jesus Christ is present to you. Turn to him in faith!

FOR YOUR INFORMATION

Information for our Parishioners and Users of Parish Facilities

The Diocese has made the decision to provide special events coverage for all locations within the Diocese. Special events is coverage that is available to users of parish facilities who will have their non-parish sponsored event at a parish facility.

Facility users must first be asked to provide proof of insurance. If they are unable to produce this coverage, they have the option of purchasing the special events coverage for the cost of \$95 (or \$125 for an overnight event). Once the application and payment have been received by Catholic Mutual, the facility user will have coverage for their event.

Special Events coverage is designed to be extended to individuals and/or organizations (either profit or non-profit). Many individuals need this coverage for events such as private wedding receptions or family reunions. Non-profit organizations such as a charity organization may need the coverage for a pancake breakfast. A for-profit organization such as a local business may need the coverage for an employee Christmas party held on parish facilities.

Risk Management Guidelines are available to assist our parish in determining whether or not an activity is parish sponsored.

The application should be submitted at least 15 business days prior to an event.

This is a new program of the diocese and will undoubtedly take time to facilitate, so we ask your cooperation and assistance. Please contact the church office if you have any questions.
