

## How to enter:

- Read the entry requirements. Here you will find turn in dates, fee information and the rules of entry. Note that there are supplemental requirements for Fine Art, Photography, Culinary and Floriculture entries. **It is your responsibility to know and follow the Entry Requirements.**
- Choose the Department, Division and Class for each of your entries. For more information about these items, please see below.
- Go to <http://vvac.fairwire.com> (if link does not work, cut and paste to your web browser) and enter your items, or pick up an entry form at the fair office.

### Department:

Defines the general grouping for your entry, for example a knitted item would be entered in the Fiber Department, a woodcarving in the Crafts Department or a painting in Fine Art.

**Divisions:** define the person entering the item to the fair. Are they an adult? A teenager? In Fine Art they might be a novice or a premium artist.

Divisions are important because they assure that entries are judged in groups of similar skill levels. So items entered by a youth (under 13) would not be judged against a skilled adult.

### Class:

Defines the specific item you are entering. For each item you must choose the Department, then the Division within the Department and then you will be asked for the class.

So if you are 40 years old and entering a loaf of sourdough bread you would be:

## Departments:

**AG Mechanics:** Welding, Metal, Plumbing, more

**Craft & Hobby:** Baskets, Collections, Papercraft, Jewelry, Woodcraft, more

**Culinary:** All Food Items

**Fiber Art:** Crochet, Knit, Lace, Weaving, more.

**Fine Art:** Drawing, Painting, Sculpture, Printmaking, more. \*new this year, includes individual, non-school artworks for Teens and Youths.

**Floriculture/Horticulture:** Gardening, Floral Arrangement, more

**Minerals Fossils & Lapidary:** Gems, Minerals, Lapidary

**Open Models and Misc:** Models from Kits or Scratch Built, more. \*new this year Lego Construction.

**Photography** – All Photography

**Quilts** – All quilts.

**Sewing & Needlework:** Clothing, Altered Clothing, Baby Boutique, Needlepoint, Embroidery, more.

**Persons with Disabilities:** All entries for persons with intellectual disabilities
