2020 Walter Hall Honorary Youth Scholarship Tournament

Please read all rules. Failure to read is no excuse!

1. Greater Baltimore USBC Youth Tournaments are open to all youth bowlers who are certified in a GBUSBCA Youth League. All USBC Youth Tournament rules and regulations will apply.
2. Initial entry closing date is Saturday April 04, 2020. Entry fee will be \$30 per bowler per event. No entry will be accepted without full fees and completely filled out entry form. No entry fee will be returned after the closing date. Any returned check is subject to a \$35 fee. Entries received after the closing date will be accepted based on lane availability.
3. The tournament will be one division with all bowlers competing together. ***There will be a special award for highest scratch series and game as well as highest handicap series and game bowled during qualifying.***
4. Handicap is 90% of the difference between the bowlers' average and 225.
5. No participant shall be allowed to use any tobacco products, drink alcoholic beverages or use foul language or gestures. Bowlers must remain within their assigned lanes during competition.
6. Attire: No hats, short cutoffs, bare midriffs or clothing with rips, tears, holes or suggestive or inappropriate language will be allowed. Tournament officials have the right to require bowler to change to appropriate attire before allowing them to participate in any event. **No electronic devices (iPods, headphones, cell phones, video games, etc.) will be allowed in the bowlers' area.**
7. Entrants shall use their highest 2019-2020 USBC Youth averages as indicated on a league standing sheet dated as of March 28, 2020 based on a minimum of 12 games. If a bowler doesn't have 12 games by March 28, 2020 then the highest current average as of April 04, 2020 based on a minimum of 12 games. If none of the following applies a tournament average of 225 will be used. **If bowlers are using a Sport Average the average will be converted to the standard average based on current USBC rule book. If the converted Sport Average is higher than the Standard Average, the converted average will be used. Tournament Director has the right to correct any mistake in age, average, handicap or tournament score.** Falsification of average will result in disqualification of the bowler.
10. USBC rule 319 A-3 will be waived with Tournament Director adjusting averages to reflect the correct average as required to ensure no one is disqualified under this rule.
11. All bowlers must check in 30 minutes prior to schedule squad time **and present current USBC sanction card**. Late bowlers shall receive 0 for all missed frames. Substitutes will be allowed and must take the original place of the original bowler.
12. Awards/Scholarships will be based on 1:5. In the event of a tie for champion, the scholarship will be evenly divided. The Tournament Committee will make the final decision regarding the distribution of all scholarship monies. All scholarship monies will be deposited into the GBUSBCA SMART Account Number 9397.
13. Any rules not covered will fall under the current USBC Playing and Tournament Rules. Any protest/appeals must be made in writing within 72 Hours to the Tournament Director. Any protest regarding scoring must be made in writing to the Tournament Director within 24 hours after the error has occurred.
