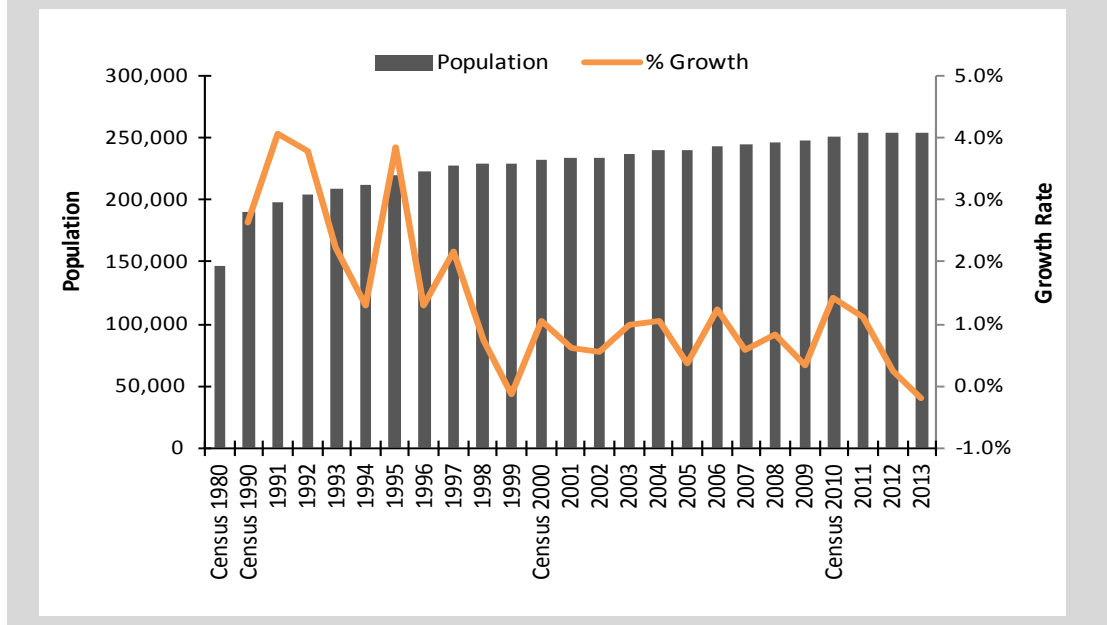

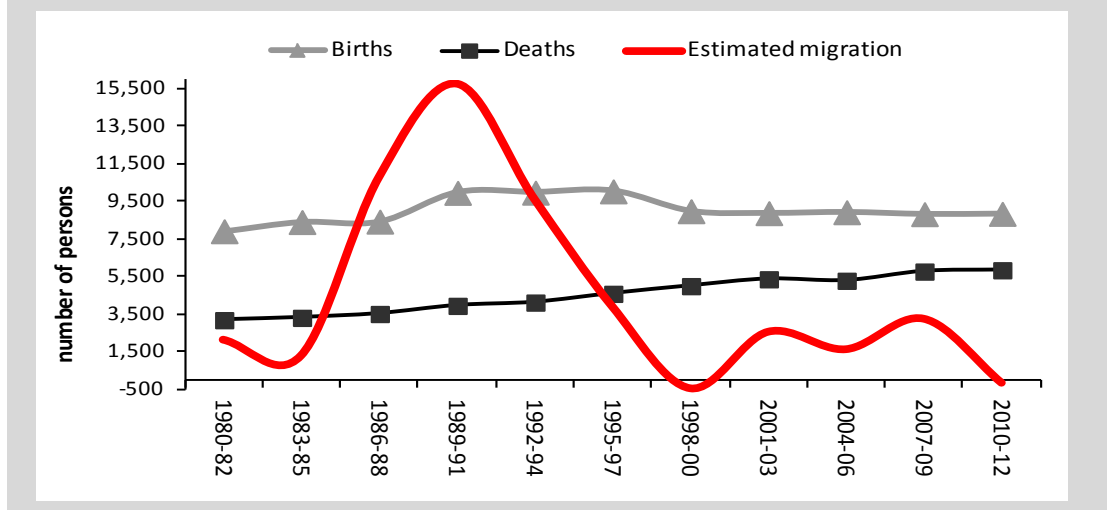

**A.1.3. POPULATION DENSITY (PERSONS PER SQUARE MILE)**

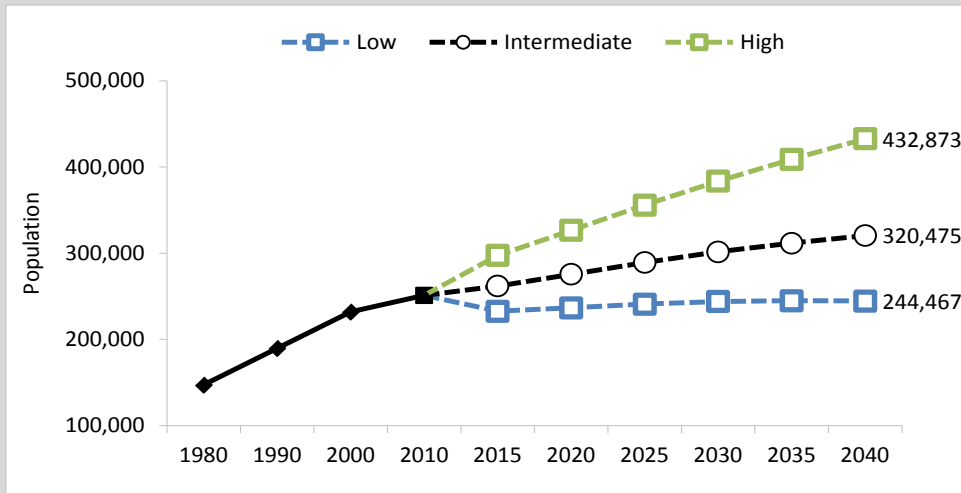

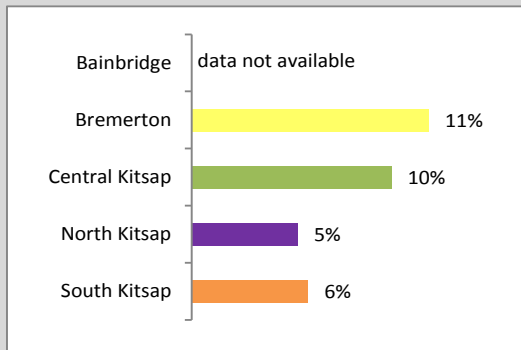

**KITSAP BY SUBGROUP: 2010-2012**



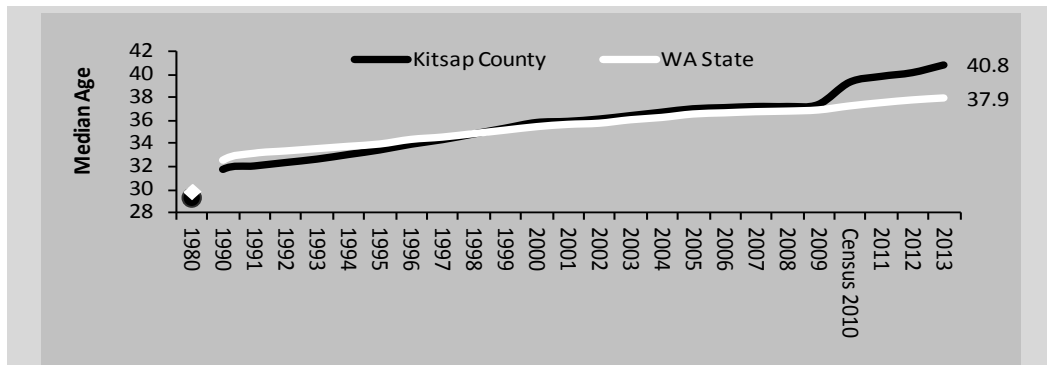

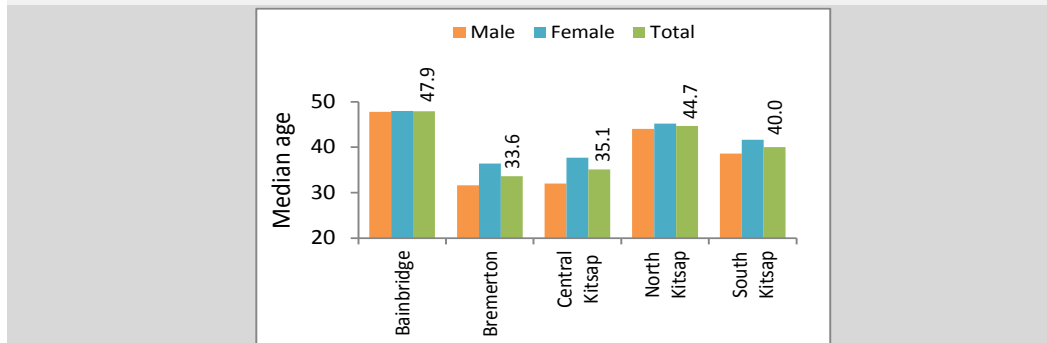

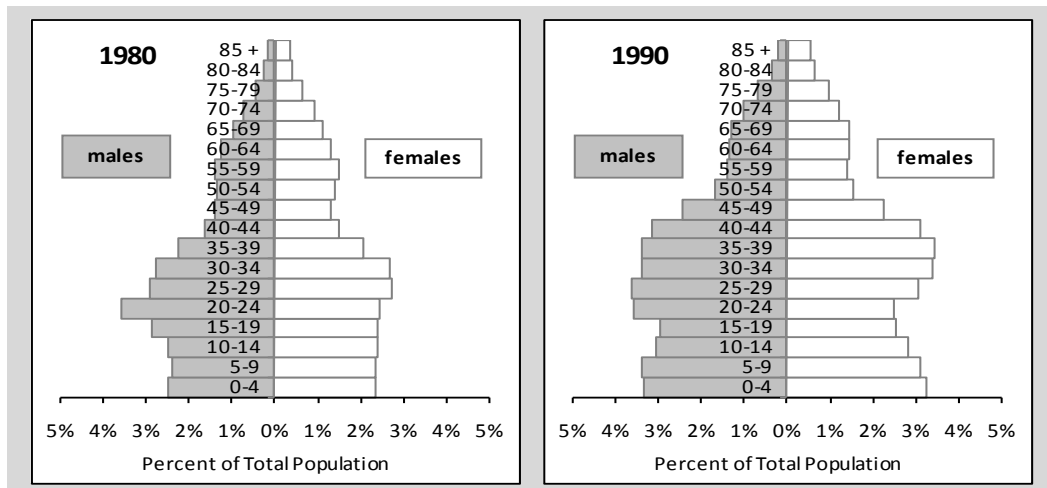
**MEDIAN AGE BY SCHOOL DISTRICT: 2010-12**

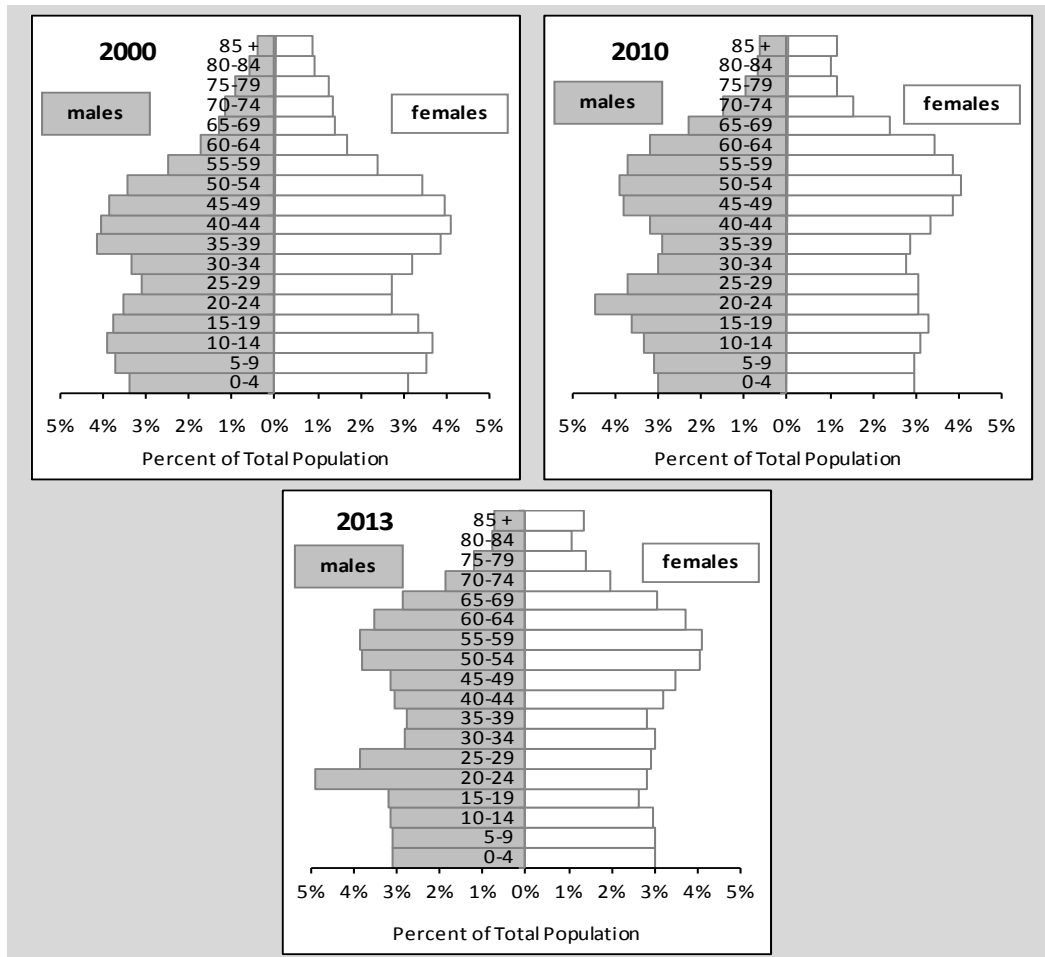


**A.2.2. POPULATION BY AGE AND GENDER**

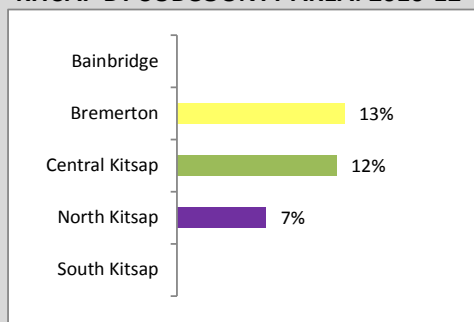

**KITSAP BY SUBCOUNTY AREA: 2010-12**



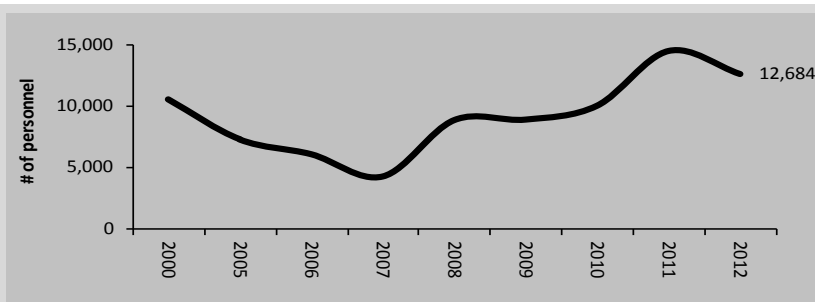

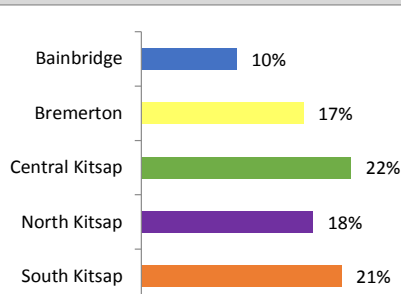

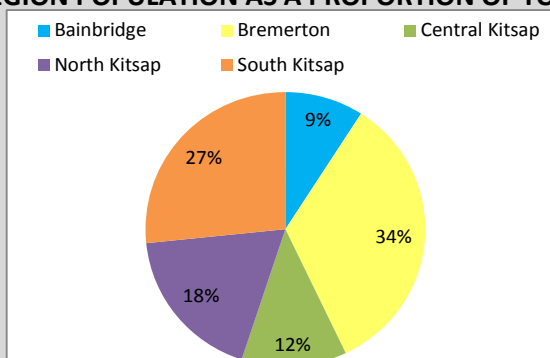
